

Exercise C1.1: Nominative and accusative nouns

Label each of the nouns in **purple** as subject or object, and then translate the noun into Latin.

Remember, the subject will be in the nominative case and the object will be in the accusative case.

e.g. The **father** praised his **son**.

subject *object*
