

## Exercise B5.3: Present tense – 1st and 2nd conjugations

The verbs in this exercise are from the vocabulary lists for Chapter 4 and Chapter 5.

Here is a reminder of the present tense endings for verbs in the 1st and 2nd conjugations.

	1st conjugation	2nd conjugation
I	am <b>ō</b>	terre <b>ō</b>
you (sg)	am <b>ās</b>	terr <b>ēs</b>
he / she / it	am <b>at</b>	terret
we	am <b>amus</b>	terr <b>emus</b>
you (pl)	am <b>ātis</b>	terr <b>ētis</b>
they	am <b>ant</b>	terrent
