3. Is the mistress walking away from **that** wall? (illā / illō)
4. The senator greeted **those** citizens. (illī / illōs)
5. The master of **those men** set that woman free. (illīus / illōrum)
6. What did you say to **that** freedman? (illī / illīs)
7. The master said **those things**. (illōs / illa)
8. On **that** road the citizen greeted the senator. (illō / illā)
9. The mistress loved **that** slave greatly. (illum / illud)
10. **That man** greeted those freedmen. (ille / illī)
