

Exercise A8.4: Verbs

Identify the tense of the Chapter 8 verbs in the table below and translate each one. Then change the form from singular to plural, or plural to singular, keeping the tense and person the same.

Remember that you need to look at the stem as well as the ending. Here are the principal parts for each verb so that you can see their different stems.

appropinquō, appropinquāre, appropinquāvī
labōrō, labōrāre, labōrāvī
legō, legere, lēgī
scrībō, scrībere, scrīpsī
cupiō, cupere, cupīvī
conveniō, convenīre, convēnī
exeō, exīre, exiī
ineō, inīre, iniī
pereō, perīre, periī
redeō, redīre, rediī

The irregular endings for **eō** and its compounds are listed on p245.
