

Exercise B8.2: Pronouns in sentences

This exercise focuses on the pronouns and verbs you have met in the vocabulary list for Chapter 8.

Give the correct form of the pronoun for the words in **purple** in the sentences below. You will need to think about the case that follows each verb and whether or not a preposition is needed.

1. My father **approached us**.
2. O freedmen, they read a letter **to you**.
3. **We** approached the fierce teacher but **you (pl)** went away.
4. Books are excellent **for us**, O Romans.
5. Because **you (sg)** were working, I read a book.
6. Don't go away from **us**!
7. He chose a book **for himself**.
8. They returned to **me**.
9. It is stupid **for us** to write this letter.
10. You (sg) have worked for a long time **for yourself**.

Remember that ***appropinquō*** is followed by a dative noun or *ad* + accusative.
