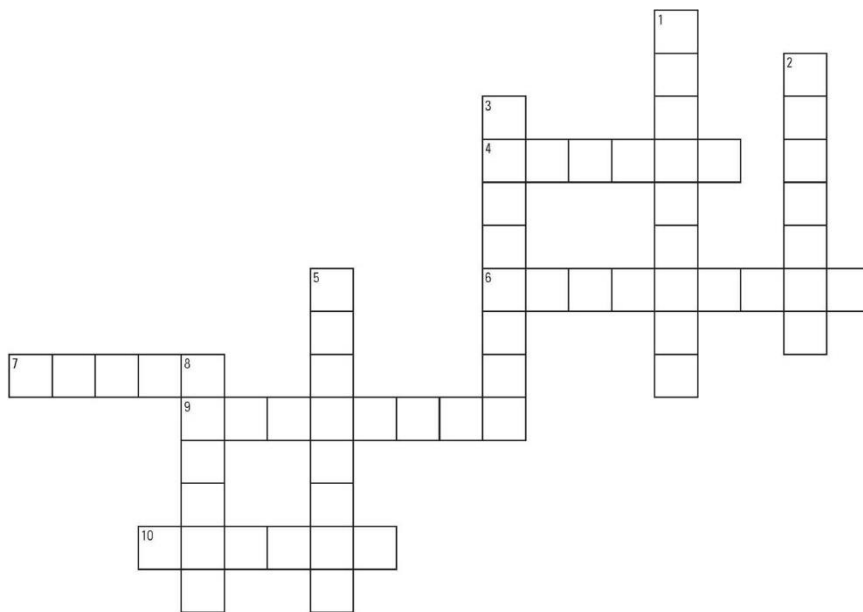


Exercise A9.1: Derivations crossword

English derivations often come from the stem of the 4th principal part of a verb.
