This exercise focuses on nouns and PPPs from the vocabulary lists for Chapters 7–9.

Work out the case needed for each noun and PPP pair in **purple** and then pick the correct Latin translation.

- The letter read by the slave was excellent. (epistula lēcta / epistulam lēctam)
- I read the books written by my father. (librī scrīptī / librōs scrīptōs)
- The wounded leader was very brave.
  (ducem vulnerātum / dux vulnerātus)
- Where is the freedman sent by the farmer? (libertum missum / libertus missus)
- The father of the seized soldier was very sad. (mīlitis raptī / mīlitem raptum)
- We ran very quickly from the overpowered inhabitants. (incolās superātōs / incolīs superātīs)
- Greeted savagely by her husband, the mistress cried for three hours. (domina salūtāta / dominam salūtātam)
- The enemy killed by our men had been very daring. (hostēs necātōs / hostēs necātī)
- In attacked towns the inhabitants are often both miserable and angry. (oppidī oppugnāti / oppidīs oppugnātīs)
- We persuaded the wounded messenger with many words. (nūntium vulnerātum / nūntiō vulnerātō)
