

Exercise B10.3: Conjugations and the imperfect passive

This exercise focuses on verbs from the vocabulary lists for Chapter 9 and Chapter 10.

Here is a reminder of the imperfect passive in all conjugations.

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| 1st conjugation | amābar | I was being loved |
| 2nd conjugation | terrēbar | I was being terrified |
| 3rd conjugation | regēbar | I was being ruled |
| 4th conjugation | audiēbar | I was being heard |
| mixed conjugation | capiēbar | I was being captured |

Give the conjugation and the imperfect passive form requested for each verb.

| | verb | conjugation | |

| 1 | teneō, tenēre | | it was being held = |
| 2 | quaerō, quaerere | | you (sg) were being searched for = |
| 3 | expectō, expectāre | | I was being waited for = |
| 4 | dēleō, dēlēre | | you (pl) were being destroyed = |
| 5 | moveō, movēre | | they were being moved = |
| 6 | necō, necāre | | she was being killed = |
| 7 | rapiō, rapere | | you (pl) were being seized = |
| 8 | custōdiō, custōdīre | | we were being guarded = |
| 9 | dēfendō, dēfendere | | it was being defended = |
| 10 | dūcō, dūcere | | they were being led = |
