3. **equus** in agrum (tractus / tracta) laetē currēbat.
4. servum laudāvistī propter **epistulās** (acceptās / accepta).
5. **cōsilium** ā senātōribus (nūntiātum / nūntiātīs) erat difficile et grave.
6. saepissimē **corpora** ā proeliō (tracta / tractī) mortua erant.
7. **hasta** ā frātre (vēnditae / vēndita) ducem mīlitum graviter vulnerāvit.
8. domina **ancillās** (collēcta / collēctās) pūniēbat.
9. tandem **hostēs** (reductī / reductōs) periērunt.
10. **iuvenis** ā patre (relictus / relictōs) librōs legēbat.
