

Ten Years of Performing Shakespeare's Contemporaries: Professional Productions of Early Modern Drama, 2011-20

This list provides a companion to my chapter on 'Performing Shakespeare's Contemporaries' in *The Arden Handbook of Shakespeare and Early Modern Drama*, ed. Michelle M. Dowd and Tom Rutter. It continues the work of Karin Brown's census of early modern drama productions between 1960 and 2010 in *Performing Early Modern Drama Today*, edited by Pascale Aebischer and Kathryn Prince, which provided an invaluable point of departure for further investigation. Though doubtless not exhaustive, the list aims to provide a detailed picture of a decade of Shakespeare's contemporaries in professional performance on UK and North American stages, beginning in 2011 and ending in 2020, and is the result of extensive online searches through archive catalogues, theatre websites and reviews—particularly those which appear in *Shakespeare Bulletin* and Peter Kirwan's *Bardathon* blog. Plays are listed alphabetically by playwright, then individual play. Productions appear in chronological order, with multiple productions in the same year listed alphabetically by directors' surname. Casting details, where available, are restricted to principal roles, and are listed alphabetically by actor's surname.
