I live at the above address with my mother and father.

On Saturday 15th April 1989 together with my mother and father and my older brother Philip I left my house to watch the cup tie at Sheffield Wednesday Hillsborough Football Ground to watch the Cup Match between Liverpool and Nottingham Forest.

We arrived at Sheffield shortly before two o'clock and my dad parked his car near to the football ground. Philip and myself then walked to the football ground we had tickets for the terraces at Leppings End.

Both Philip and myself went into the ground by gate 'B' and we went through the turnstiles where the tickets were taken from us. We then walked to the Central Tunnel it would be about 2.00pm at this time and on going down the tunnel we went on the right hand side and into

pen No three.

At this time there was quite a crowd at the back of the terraces but plenty of room down the front so we went down to the first barriers away from the actual fence. We didn't stand in front of the barrier but to the side of it.
