### Karl Weick/Dropping your tools/ Sensemaking

**Theme**: Weick's sensemaking. Some of the following clips are from the original 1952 movie. The idea of Weick's sensemaking is that reality is an 'ongoing accomplishment that emerges from efforts to create order.' I have included these clips to remind ourselves of the role sensemaking in constructing reality. Weick (1993) explained why the 13 young men had perished, despite the fact that the foreman, Wagner Dodge, made new sense of the rapidly changing situation by shouting for everyone to drop their firefighting tools, improvising by lighting a grass fire, and lying down in the ashes.
