Translation

Good evening! After the exams, if God wills, I will travel to Norway to visit my friends and I'll return to attend the graduation party.

I'd like to teach politics in Palestine in the future, God willing, and actually I hope that there will be peace in Palestine in the future.

Notes

- ان شاء الله الله (in shā' allāh), 'if God wills', is an expression very commonly used when talking about the future.
- ✓ عفلة التخرّج (ḥaflat at-takharruj) = graduation; حفلة التخرّج (ḥaflat at-takharruj) = graduation party
