Letters/Syllables as **Dots/Musical Notes**

Letters make words like "Go" and "Stop".

Dots make notes that Beat like a clock.

Syllables form words to make good sense.

Notes form rhythms which sound an event.

Whole Language Activity

- Whole note divides into two half notes.
- Two half notes divide into four quarter notes.
- Four quarter notes divide into eight eighth notes.
- Eight eighth notes divide into sixteen sixteenth notes.



- A Half Note is a Whole Note with a Stem.
- A Quarter Note is a Half Note Colored In.
- Eighth Notes wave a flag out from the Stem.
- Two flags mean Sixteenth Notes faster then.
- Beams connect a single or double flag.
- Dot after a note adds plus one.
