

## Exercise B1.4: Nominative and accusative (pl) adjectives

The plural nominative and accusative endings for *īrātus* are as follows:

|               | 1st declension | 2nd declension | 3rd declension |
|---------------|----------------|----------------|----------------|
| nominative pl | fēmin-ae       | de-ī           | reg-ēs         |
| accusative pl | fēmin-ās       | de-ōs          | reg-ēs         |

Make the adjective *īrātus* agree in case, gender and number with each of the following plural nouns, and then translate each phrase.

e.g. fīliae     *fīliae īrātae* → *angry daughters*
