

## Exercise B5.4: Present tense – 3rd and 4th conjugations

The verbs in this exercise are from the vocabulary lists for Chapter 4 and Chapter 5.

Here is a reminder of present tense endings for verbs in the 3rd and 4th conjugations.

	3rd conjugation	4th conjugation
I	reg <b>ō</b>	audi <b>ō</b>
you (sg)	reg <b>is</b>	audi <b>is</b>
he / she / it	reg <b>it</b>	audi <b>it</b>
we	reg <b>imus</b>	audi <b>imus</b>
you (pl)	reg <b>itis</b>	audi <b>itis</b>
they	reg <b>unt</b>	audi <b>unt</b>

The endings for mixed conjugation verbs such as *capiō* are exactly the same as for *audiō*.

Give the meaning of the following verbs and identify their conjugation. Then give the 3rd person (pl) form of the present tense for each verb.
