Here is a reminder of the future tense endings in the 3rd and 4th conjugations.

	3rd conjugation	4th conjugation
I	reg am	audi am
you (sg)	reg ēs	audi ēs
he / she / it	rege t	audi et
we	reg ēmus	audi ēmus
you (pl)	reg ētis	audi ētis
they	rege nt	audi ent
