

Exercise B9.4: Noun and participle pairs

This exercise focuses on nouns and PPPs from the vocabulary lists for Chapters 7–9.

Work out the case needed for each noun and PPP pair in **purple** and then pick the correct Latin translation.

1. The **letter read** by the slave was excellent. (epistula lēcta / epistulam lēctam)
2. I read the **books written** by my father. (librī scrīptī / librōs scrīptōs)
3. The **wounded leader** was very brave. (ducem vulnerātum / dux vulnerātus)
4. Where is the **freedman sent** by the farmer? (libertum missum / libertus missus)
5. The father of the **seized soldier** was very sad. (mīlitis raptī / mīlitem raptum)
6. We ran very quickly from the **overpowered inhabitants**. (incolās superātōs / incolīs superātīs)
7. **Greeted** savagely by her husband, the **mistress** cried for three hours. (domina salūtāta / dominam salūtātam)
8. The **enemy killed** by our men had been very daring. (hostēs necātōs / hostēs necātī)
9. In **attacked towns** the inhabitants are often both miserable and angry. (oppidī oppugnāti / oppidīs oppugnātīs)
10. We persuaded the **wounded messenger** with many words. (nūntium vulnerātum / nūntiō vulnerātō)
