

## Perspectives and levels

You can already see the wealth of ideas you can generate, but there is more. As we've said, original thinkers invent new questions to open up new perspectives others have not seen. Likewise, we need a method that gets us to think outside our own limited perspective in order to ask questions we might otherwise dismiss as irrelevant and unthinkable.

After you've answered all your trigger questions, do two things:

- 1 Examine your topic from the perspective of all those involved: all those who affect or are affected by it
- 2 As you do this, think about each one on the different levels listed below
