From a newspaper article about allergies:

Any inappropriate and uncomfortable reaction to a stimulus, whether the stimulus is food or drink, a chemical or something environmental such as pollen may be termed as an 'allergy'.

Keeping your own list

Keeping a list of all of the superfluous words you use will help you de-clutter your writing so that readers can see your points more clearly and understand your ideas without having to strip the prose down to get at them. Take any of the following words and start your own list by adding words when you become aware that you use them unnecessarily. Then, when you come to revise your work, look at the list and remind yourself what you need to look for.
