I Arguments

- 1.1 Does the conclusion follow from the reasons given?
 - Qualifiers
 - Distributing terms
 - Converting claims
 - Affirming and denying
- 1.2 Are there hidden assumptions in the argument?

2 Evidence

- 2.1 Does the author have enough reliable evidence?
 - Untypical examples/insufficient or weighted evidence
- 2.2 Does he represent the evidence accurately?
 - Statistics
- 2.3 Does he draw reliable inferences from it?
 - Analogies
 - Oversimplifying (stereotypes, straw men, special pleading, false dilemma)
 - Invalid causal inferences (post hoc fallacy, cause/correlation, multiple and underlying causes)
- 2.4 Are the inferences relevant?
 - Attacking the person, popularity, authority, fear, compromise

3 Language

- 3.1 Is the author's meaning clear?
 - Jargon
 - Loaded language
 - Begging the question
- 3.2 Does she use words consistently?
 - Equivocation
