## **Translation**

Hello! My name's Mahmoud. My apartment is in the city of Cairo.

The apartment is near the River Nile, in a street called "Doctor Fawzi Muftah Street".

There's a large bank at the start of the street, and a cinema next to the house [i.e. the apartment building].

In the apartment there isn't a television and there isn't internet because I don't live there. I live in the city of Oxford.

## Notes

(awwal <u>ash-shārie</u>) means 'the start of the street', in contrast to أوّل <u>ال</u>شارع (awwal shārie) which means 'the first street'.
(li'annī) = 'because I'
