Transcript

مرحباً! اسمي عَبدو. أنا مِن مدينة غَزّة في فلسطين. أنا طالب في جامعة لندن، هنا في بريطانيا.

كُلّ يَوم أصحو من النوم الساعة الثامنة صباحاً.

آكُل "الكورن فليكس" للإفطار، ولكِن نَحنُ الآن في شَهر رَمَضان. أشرَب عادةً كوب من عَصير الفَواكِه وأَذهَب إلى الجامعة بالباص. أرجع إلى الشقّة الساعة الحادية عَشَرة مَساءً وآخُذ دُش، وأنام.

Translation

Hello! My name's Abdou. I'm from Gaza city in Palestine.

I'm a student at the University of London, here in Britain.

Every day I wake up [from sleep] at eight o'clock in the morning. I eat cornflakes for breakfast, but now we're in the month of Ramadan. I usually drink a glass of fruit juice and go to the university by bus.

I return to the apartment at eleven o'clock in the evening, and I take a shower and go to sleep.

Notes

- ✓ During the Islamic month of Ramadan, Muslims fast between sunrise and sunset. Abdou refers to the fact that he is talking during Ramadan and so his eating and drinking routine is different from usual.
- دش (dush) = shower (from the French word 'douche').
