

My Day

Title: Mastering Arabic 1 Unit number: 16 Topic: Every day Aim: To practice asking and talking about your daily routine Materials needed: • Question & answer sheets (one per student)

Pair work is an effective way of getting all the students in a class talking. In this activity, forming the correct questions is just as important as giving the answers.

Step 1

- ✓ Complete *Mastering Arabic 1*, Unit 16, pages 211–24 and the associated exercises.
- ✓ Print out the attached question and answer sheet.

Step 2

✓ Go through the question prompts on the right of the sheet with all the students and elicit Arabic questions for asking a male or a female. Questions should be as below (or similar). (Point out the pronunciation of the feminine verb in the first question.)

Give a few sample answers, for example: أصحو الساعة السابعة. أخرج من البيت الساعة الثامنة والربع.

Step 3

- ✓ Divide the students into pairs. One student asks the questions, the other answers. The first student notes down the answer in the space provided on the sheet.
- Move around the pairs listening and making suggestions if necessary.
- ✓ Ask the students to switch roles when they have completed the questions.

Step 4

✓ Students write out questions and their answers for homework.

Higher-ability students can report back to the class and/or write about what their partner does every day, for example.
