

Mastering Arabic: *Passive verb tables*

Passive Verbs: Present and past tense

Below is a table of basic passive verbs with their vowels, divided into present and past tenses.

Past tense	Present tense	
(I was transported) نُقِلْتُ	(I am transported) أَنْقَلُ	أنا
(you m. were transported) نُقِلْتَ	(you m. are transported) تُنْقَلُ	أنتَ
(you f. were transported) نُقِلْتِ	(you f. are transported) تُنْقَلِينَ	أنتِ
(he/it was transported) نُقِلَ	(he/it is transported) يُنْقَلُ	هو
(she/it was transported) نُقِلَتْ	(she/it is transported) تُنْقَلُ	هي
(we were transported) نُقِلْنَا	(we are transported) نُنْقَلُ	نحنُ
(you m. pl. were transported) نُقِلْتُمْ	(you m. pl. are transported) تُنْقَلُونَ	أنتمُ
(you f. pl. were transported) نُقِلْتُنَّ	(you f. pl. are transported) تُنْقَلْنَ	أنتنَّ
(you dual were transported) نُقِلْتُمَا	(you dual are transported) تُنْقَلَانِ	أنتما
(they m. were transported) نُقِلُوا	(they m. are transported) يُنْقَلُونَ	همُ
(they f. were transported) نُقِلْنَ	(they f. are transported) يُنْقَلْنَ	هنَّ
(they dual were transported) نُقِلَا	(they dual are transported) يُنْقَلَانِ	هُمَا

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
