On the website, they can further their understanding by reading articles and watching videos on referencing basics, and use the reference builder to create their own accurate references.

Your access options:

Institution Single Sign On

Single Sign On allows students to access the resource using their current college/university account details.

- No additional usernames/passwords for your students to remember.
- Provides access on and off campus.
- One-time registration is required the first time students access the referencing tutorial.

IP Range

IP access allows users to use the service on a device that is connected to a specified local network. (e.g. the institution's campus Wi-Fi network).

- Users are not required to login if the device is within the specified local network.
- Users outside of the specified local network will not be able to gain access to the service.
- Users are required to create a personal username and password for the referencing tutorial in order to save progress. They are required to login each time they access the tutorial.

Referrer URL:

Users can access the service by clicking on a specific URL link that we provide.

- Users are not required to login if they access the service by clicking the referrer url.
- The link will only work if hosted within a specified institution domain.
- One-time registration is required the first time students access the referencing tutorial.
- The referrer URL link must be placed in a password protected environment.
