Module R3 Quiz Answer Key

Question 1:
Treating ourselves or another person with regard and attention. Example: It is respectful to take others' boundaries seriously and not cross them.

Question 2:
Being kind and offering care or support when someone (or ourselves) is hurting. Example: I offer help to a smaller child who has fallen at recess. Or I give myself a break if I am exhausted.

Question 3:
Picking up my own trash and perhaps other litter when I see it.
Take student examples as offered if relevant.
Question 4:
Fear based means I only act well if I'm afraid of getting in trouble or that someone will hurt me if I don't comply.
Real respect means I truly hold a person or place in high regard and act accordingly.
Question 5:
Accept all relevant student thoughts.
