Question 1:

Thoughts about sex, feelings in a person’s body, family opinion, religious beliefs, community norms, TV or movies, social media, friends, pressure from others.
Accept student thoughts if relevant to the topic
Question 3:
If you think you would like to, I would like to take you to the movies this weekend.
An “If” statement directed at the person you are inviting— followed by a statement of desire or invitation.
Question 4:
Baseball—sports have winners and losers, it’s a game, someone playing offense and defense and so forth.
Pizza—collaborative, can have some but no pressure to “eat” it all, requires discussion to decide what’s on the pizza, and more.
