

Glossary of terms

a starchy powder possibly used to draw out Arrow root:

poison from wounds

starch used to make puddings, a bit like semolina Sago:

rice soaked in water, said to be used to stop Rice water:

diarrhoea and upset stomach

Barley water: a drink made from boiling up barley and

flavoured, used to build up a patient's strength

Beef tea: drink made from boiling pieces of beef, used to

build up patient's strength

Marsala: type of wine

Brandy: very strong alcoholic drink

Port: strong, sweet type of red wine drunk at end of

meal

Isinglass: a form of gelatine made from fish innards used to

make jelly or glue

Weights and measures:

Gallon: 4.5 litres approximately

Quarts: one quarter of a gallon, roughly just over a litre

454 grams 1lb:

1 ounce: 28 grams

16 ounces: 1lb
