

Sue:	I jus' <u>can</u> 't seem t' get this one to go in the <u>ho</u> :le.	Speaker self-selects. Telling FPP requires a response. Doesn't select next speaker.
Sally:	You h've tha' problem too?	Speaker self-selects. Current speaker selects next. Question FPP requires next speaker. Talk is designed as a second to Sue's talk and orients to it (disambiguates <i>you</i>).
Sue:	Yea:h. .hh How does Prue get hers so: <u>neat</u> like tha'.	Selected by previous speaker. Does not select next speaker. Question FPP requires a speaker, but no-one is selected. (Prue is not speaker selection as the question is designed to be about Prue not addressed to Prue.)
Prue:	Oh <u>I</u> don' think it's so <u>neat</u> . I mess it up a:(h)ll the(h) ti:(h)me. .heh	Speaker self-selects. Does not select next speaker.
Sue:	Oh no you're <u>so</u> goo:d at it. <u>I</u> sn't she Sally.	Speaker self-selects. Current speaker selects next. Question FPP requires a next speaker. Turn is addressed to Sally using her name.
Sally:	Su:re is. Puts us <u>all</u> to <u>shame</u> .	Selected by previous speaker. Does not select next speaker.
