

A Note on the Text

Since the current volume is intended chiefly to aid students in their preparation for OCR's AS and A Level examinations, the text has been taken from H. Grose-Hodge's volume 'Murder at Larinum' (1932, reprinted in 1992). All omissions and textual readings have been preserved from Grose-Hodge's version in order to make the text in this volume as close to the text which will be printed in the examinations as possible. The only four alterations in this edition are: the expansion of abbreviated names (in order to ease comprehension for students unfamiliar with the conventions of abbreviating Roman names); the addition of *et* in Section 32 to make it clearer that two men are being mentioned (*Hortensio* et *Quinto Metello consulibus*); the removal of a comma after *exclamat* in Section 10 to aid the flow of an indirect statement; and finally, the addition of ¹ or ² to denote which Oppianicus is being referred to (Oppianicus ¹ = Oppianicus the Elder; Oppianicus ² = Oppianicus the Younger).

The numbering of sections has also been taken from Grose-Hodge. I offer below an explanation of how Grose-Hodge's numbering of sections (the ones included in this volume) matches the OCT version of the text (edited by A. C. Clark (1905)) and note any significant omissions, for the interest of readers.
