



Comparison of Section Numbers with OCT

AS and A Level Sections

The AS Level selection (Sections 1-7 and Sections 10 and 11) deals mainly with the crimes of Oppianicus the Elder. Sassia's behaviour as the love rival of her daughter is also included.

The sections of the OCT which it includes are sections 11-31 (with omissions) and sections 40-42 (with omissions).

The Latin of the A Level selection (Sections 27-32 and Sections 35-37) deals with the alleged poisoning of Oppianicus the Elder and Sassia's subsequent behaviour, attempting to have her son condemned for her husband's murder. The sections of the OCT which it includes are 169-180 (with omissions) and 185-194 (with omissions).

The A Level also requires students to have read, in English, sections 9-18, 43-61 and 181-185. These section numbers correspond with the OCT section numbers; a summary of what is included in these sections can be found in the **Introduction** of the book.

Section Numbers compared with OCT

The numbering of sections given by OCR and used in the Bloomsbury volume has been taken from Grose-Hodge's edition: **Murder in Latinum**. Below is a table explaining how Grose-Hodge's numbering of sections compares with the OCT version of the text (edited by A. C. Clark (1905)); any significant omissions are noted. It is hoped that this will be of use to those preparing versions of the text themselves without access to Grose-Hodge's original.
