THIS WEEK'S SERMON RECAP

One thing Jesus taught his disciples over and over again is how to love through acts of service. He modeled it with his life, seeking to serve rather than to be served. From the beginning of eternity to creation, thru the outworking redemption after the fall, to the end of eternity, the Father, Son, and Spirit pour themselves out in humble service of each other and creation, and even fallen creatures like you and me. The great problem we face is that love almost always involves acts of service that require the expenditure of energy. A lot of us are simply too drained, or to be honest, just too lazy to spend energy on acts of service because we've devoted our energy to other things. But the truth about love is that love just boils down to acts of service. As we grow in servanthood, people discover it really is a better way to live. Somewhere along the line you discover Jesus really knew what he was talking about, that it is truly better to give than to receive. Love serves.

- 1. Jesus says, "The great among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first must be a slave of all." Are you comfortable with this mandate? Why or why not?
- 2. Pastor Matt says he, "believes the greatest tragedy of Christianity is Christian people who've grown up in the faith have never allowed God to use their lives to do anything." What is your response to this and what do you think would help you to grow in this area?
- 3. The problem most of us face when it comes to love is not that we don't know how to do loving things, it's that something blocks us from doing it. What are some of the things that get in our way? (Consider: gender roles, ego, pride, laziness, attitude...)



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS (CONT)

- 4. Why did Jesus wash his disciples dirty feet? What other ultimate act of service did he perform for all of us and why?
- 5. What are the signs of spiritual maturity when it comes to serving?
- 6. Acts of service to others = Love. Paul in Philippians 2:5-8 says, "You should adopt the way of thinking that was also adopted by Christ Jesus who precisely because he was in the very nature God... became a servant." Think about your relationships. What acts of service for others can you commit to doing this week?
- 7. If God were completely in charge of your life, what area of service in the church or community might he be leading you to?
