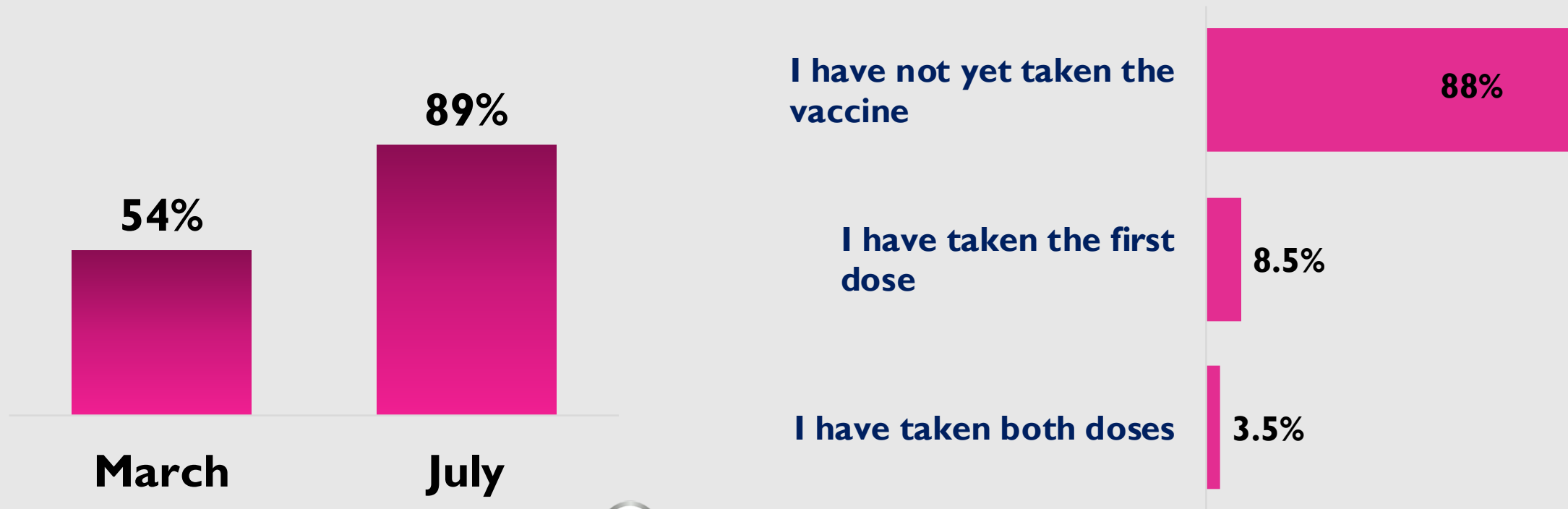
Methodology

- ❖ 400 qualitative surveys
 - ❖ 160 Eastern Freetown
 - ❖ 120 Central Freetown
 - ❖ 120 Western Freetown
- ❖ 51/49 gender split
- ❖ 10 data collectors
- ❖ Boots on the ground
- ❖ Electronic data capture
- ❖ Margin of Error: +/- 4.9%

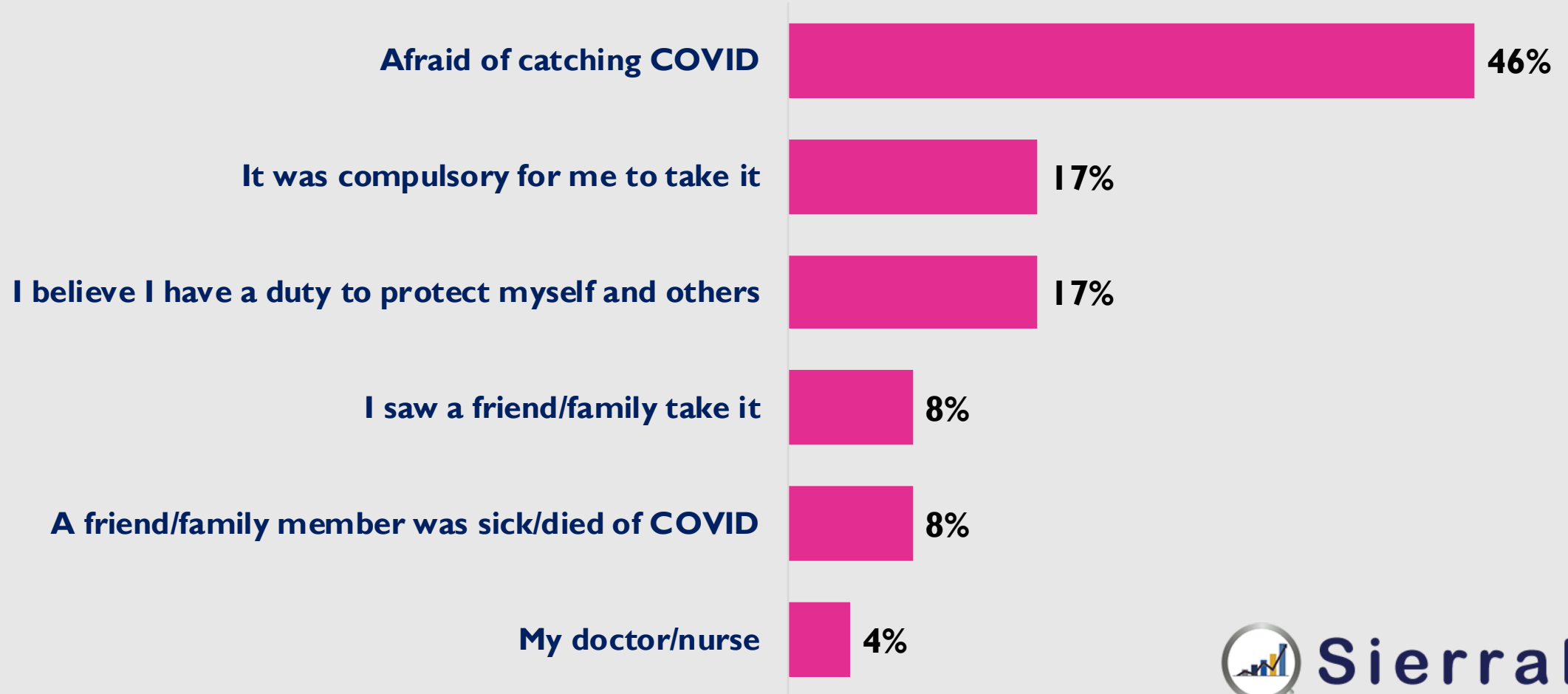
Vaccine Awareness and Uptake in Freetown

12% said they have taken at least one dose

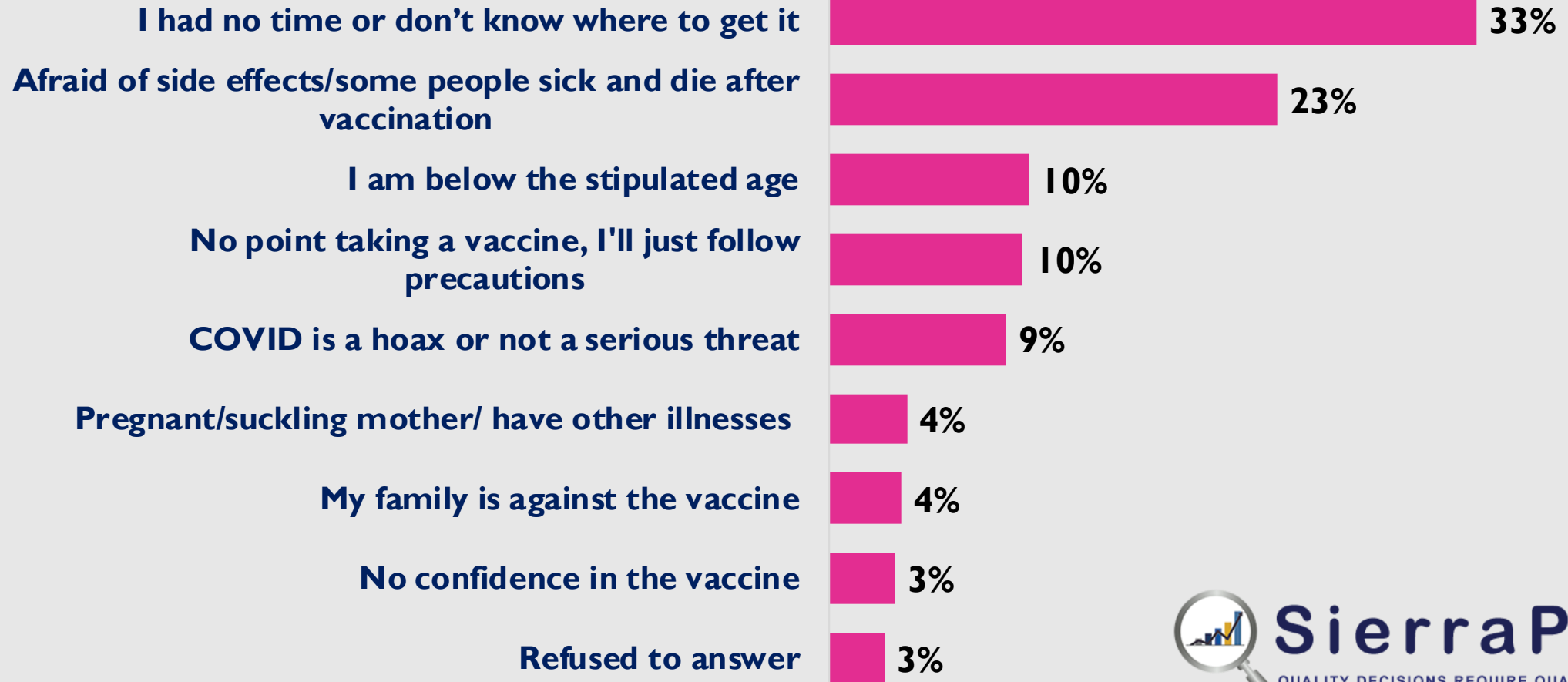


Why People Take Vaccines in Freetown?

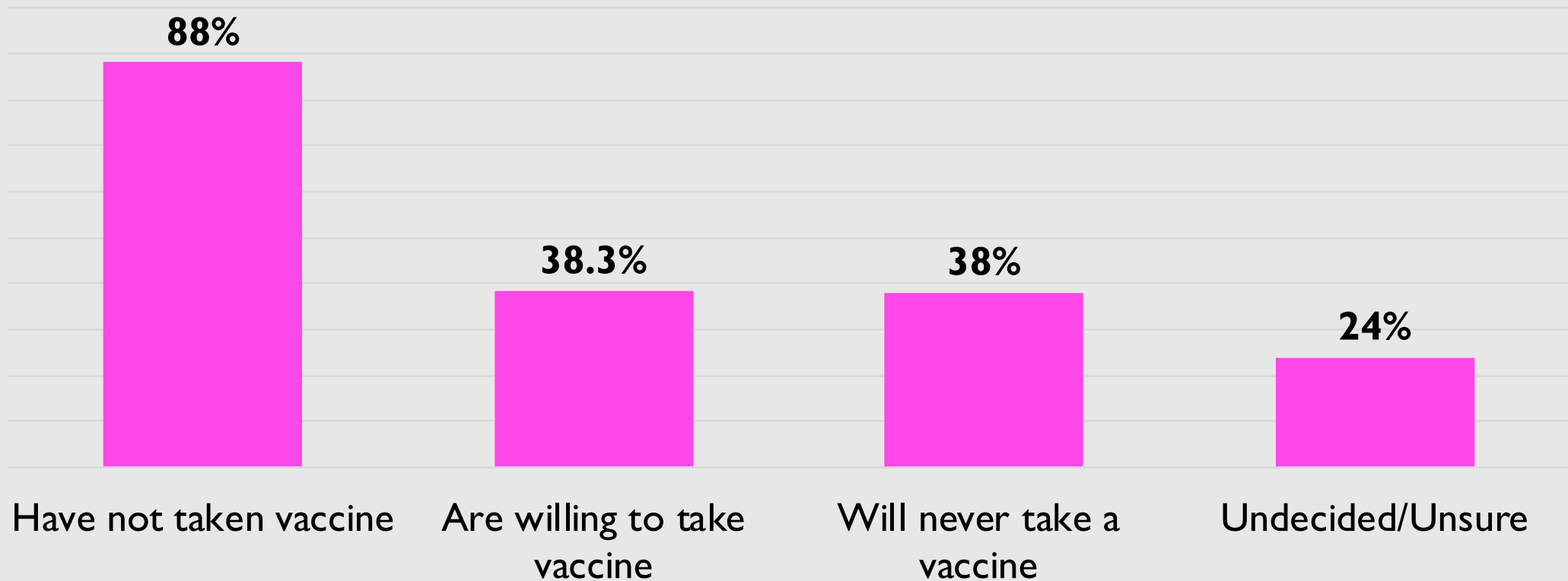

Rationale for Low Vaccine Uptake in Freetown



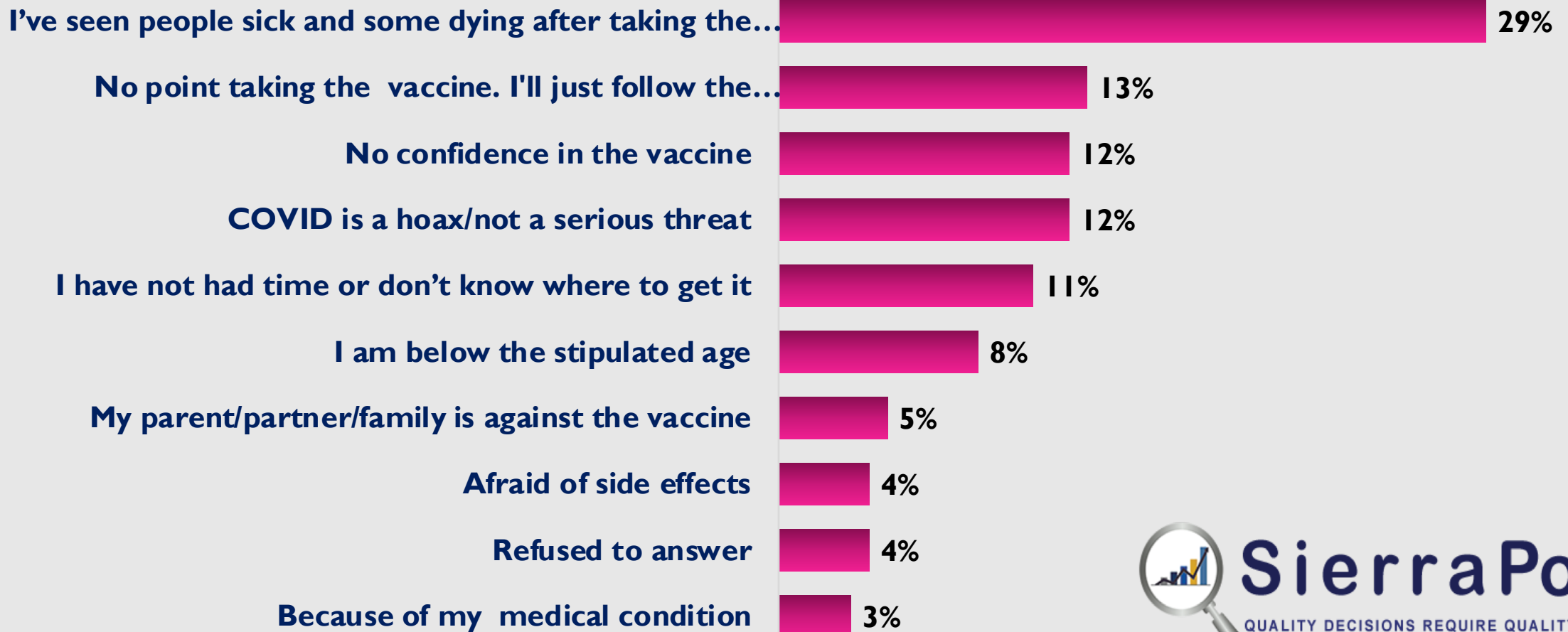
Vaccine Resistance/Hesitancy in Freetown
