## Sample PDF – Page 1/2

The benefit of adding samples to your book landing page on Bookpages.net is that it gives you the opportunity to showcase your writing and “hook” the reader into wanting more!

Bookpages.net gives you two ways to provide samples of your book. The first is by adding samples directly to the page – either as a image (JPG, GIF, or PNG) or as a PDF file – that visitors can click on to view a page, a few pages, or an entire chapter from your book!

This sample was created by saving two pages from a word processor in PDF format.

When you upload a PDF sample to Bookpages.net an image thumbnail is automatically created and displayed on your landing page.

When a visitor clicks on the thumbnail image the PDF file opens in a pop-up window and the user can read all pages in the PDF.

The benefit of using PDF samples is that you can provide multiple pages or even an entire chapter without creating individual images for each page.

The second way is by allowing you to integrate a Mailchimp email list to your page and collect email addresses in exchange for a sample of your book.

You can offer a free chapter in exchange for an email address and start building a mailing list you can use to continue to market your book to potential readers.
