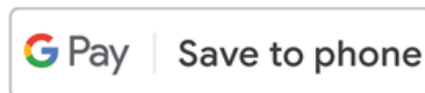


Guide for Android digital matchday tickets

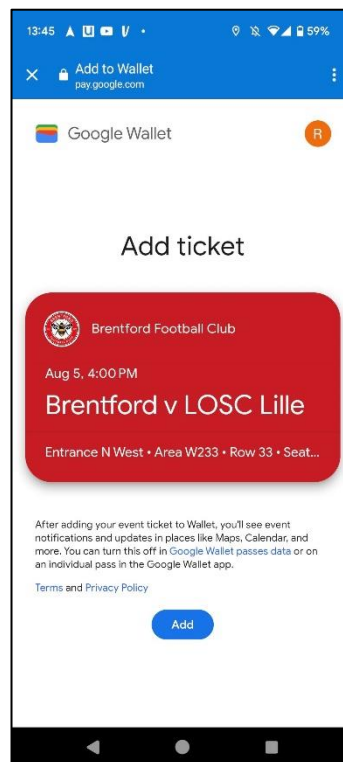
This short guide will help you download your digital ticket and add it to your Google Wallet in preparation for matchday.

How to download your digital pass on your Android device:

1. Open the email on your desired mobile device. You will be able to access your digital tickets via the order confirmation email received after you purchased your ticket.
2. For Android users, tap the "G Pay - Save to Phone" icon in the email's body.



3. A pop-up will appear, and you should add the pass to your G Pay account by tapping "Add."



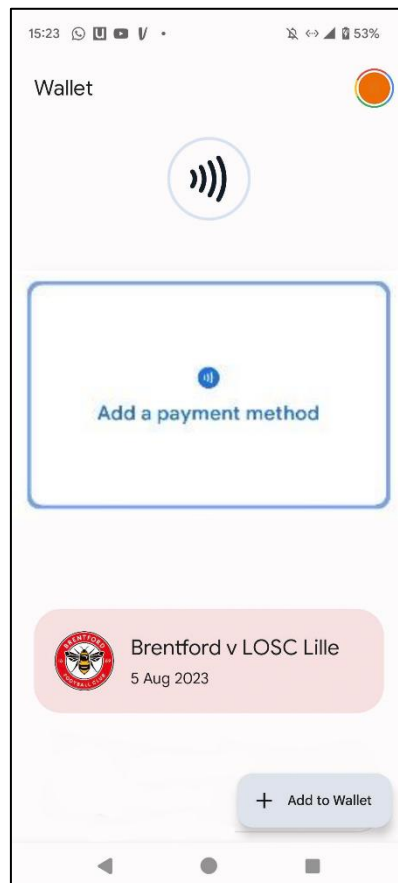
4. Your pass is now saved to your Google account. Once the ticket is in your wallet, you will not require WiFi to access it.

Understanding and accessing your digital matchday ticket on matchday:

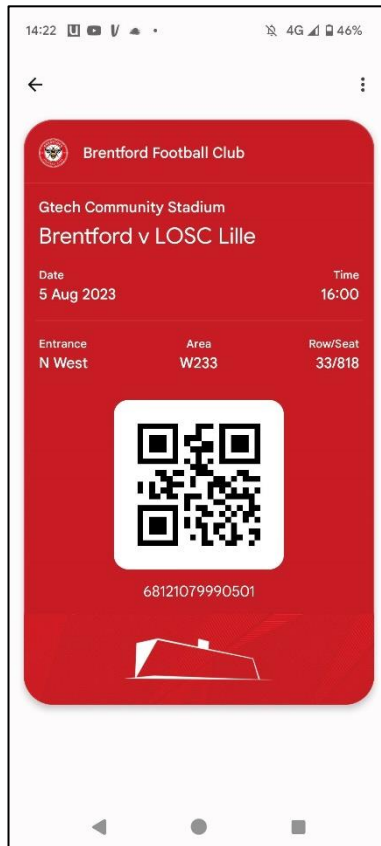
1. To access your digital matchday ticket on the day of the match, open your Google Wallet app.



2. Tap on the BFC icon to bring up your digital ticket.



- The pass will be displayed, showing entrance and seat details. For more information, select the three dots in the top right corner. You will be able to see a detailed description of your ticket including price class, fan number, restrictions and more.

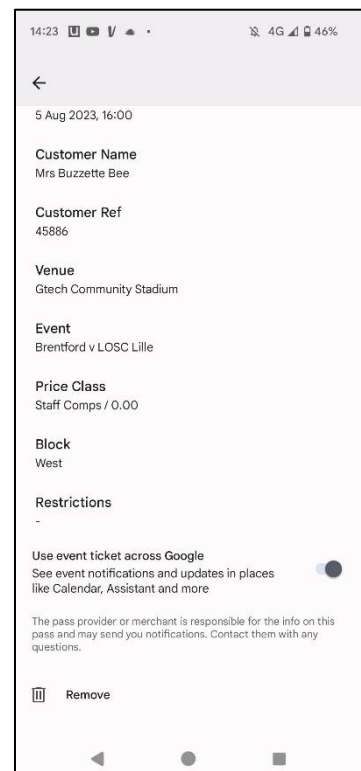
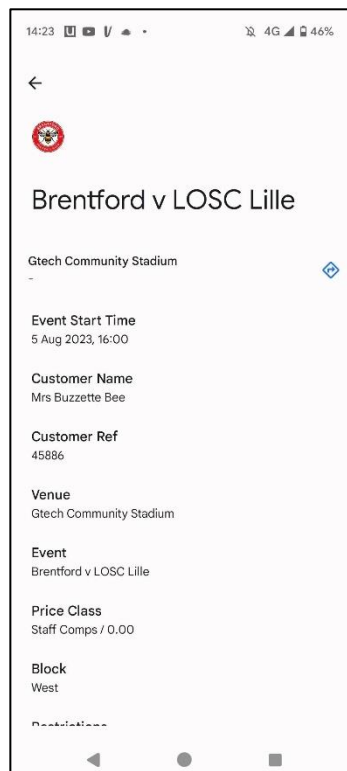


Additional details:
