Linda Miller Savitt is a graduate of Loyola Law School's Evening Program, which she attended while working as a budget analyst for the City of Los Angeles. She is a partner in the law firm of Ballard Rosenberg Golper & Savitt, LLP.

Ms. Savitt's practice consists of defending labor and employment matters on behalf of management. She has tried more than 75 jury trials, numerous court trials and several arbitrations, with 90 percent of her trials including punitive damages allegations. She has received defense verdicts in approximately 90 percent of her trials.

In 2011, Ms. Savitt served as president of the Association of Southern California Defense Counsel. She is a fellow with the American College of Trial Lawyers, an invitation-only organization. She also is an Advocate member of the American Board of Trial Advocates (ABOTA).

Ms. Savitt has repeatedly been named one of California's Top Women Litigators by the Los Angeles *Daily Journal* since 2003 and Top Labor and Employment Lawyers since 2009. The *Los Angeles Times* named her Labor and Employment Lawyer of the Year in 2011. She is a member of Loyola's Advocacy Institute Advisory Board. She hosts Loyola externs who are seeking real law-firm experience. She also hosts an ABOTA fellow every fall.

In addition to practicing law, she is currently a board member for the Jonsson Comprehensive Cancer Center Foundation. She enjoys spending time with her husband, a retired Los Angeles County Deputy District Attorney. Together they love to travel, especially to Italy, bike ride, entertain and just be together.
