

Summary of Falls on Cross Country Courses for 2014/15 Season

This summary is based on 64,269 XC starters on 560 BE & FEI courses for UK competitions that were entered into the BE database on the 31st August 2015.

Due to data errors, nine events, covering 33 courses with a total of 3,752 starters were not included in the analysis

The severity of the rider's injury is based on the fence judges' initial assessment; this assessment may be revised in the light of further medical information. The assessment is based on the following guidelines:

- **Fatal** Death within 30 days as a result of injuries sustained in the accident; not death from natural causes.
- **Serious** Admitted to hospital as an in-patient either immediately or later as a result of the injuries sustained in the accident, or died more than 30 days after the accident from injuries sustained; or one or more of the following injuries: fracture, internal injury, severe cuts or lacerations, crushing, concussion.
- **Slight** One or more of the following injuries: sprains, bruises, and cuts judged not to be severe.
- No Injury No recorded injuries.

It should be noted when looking at any FEI data analysis that they have different injury criteria:

- Serious is "Permanent Disability"
- Slight is "Temporary Disability"

Therefore a lot of injuries we consider serious such as fractures and concussion the FEI categorise as slight.



Summary of Falls on Cross Country Courses for 2014/15 Season

64,269 XC starters on 560 BE & FEI courses for UK competitions. 1,828 falls in total on the XC at Events, 1,721 occurred at a fence, 107 occurred on the flat.

Using the combined result from table 4 overleaf this gives us the following risk factors for the different types of fall:

Somersault horse fall 28% risk of a serious/fatal outcome

Non-somersault horse fall 7% risk of a serious/fatal outcome

Unseated rider fall 2% risk of a serious/fatal outcome
