All horses competing under FEI Rules are required to be vaccinated in accordance with FEI Veterinary Regulations and Rules for Eventing. These require that booster vaccinations be given within 6 months of the first date of competition, which may be extended by 21 days in order to provide a window for re-vaccination; a shorter interval is permitted, but this will set the date for the next booster vaccination.		
Due to DEFRA regulations horses/ponies should already have an existing passport. Therefore all of the FEI passports issued will be FEI recognition card passports. This means that a recognition card with additional pages will be put round your existing passport, eliminating the need for a vet to come out and complete a new passport. In the event that a horse/pony has no passport whatsoever you will need to purchase a National passport before we can issue a recognition card.

- Passport received in BE office.
- Passport is issued out from BEF via BE
- The passport is then sent by BE office to owner/rider
- On completion passport returned to the BE office
- BEF validate passport which takes at least 14 days when received in BEF office
- Validated passport is returned to owner/rider

EMERGENCY PASSPORT VALIDATION

In exceptional circumstances the BEF will validate a passport within a 48 hour period. For this service the BEF will charge £69.00 on top of the cost of the passport. Cheques made payable to BE. Therefore it is in your best interest to check passports regularly and order new passports well in advance so you do not incur any additional costs.
