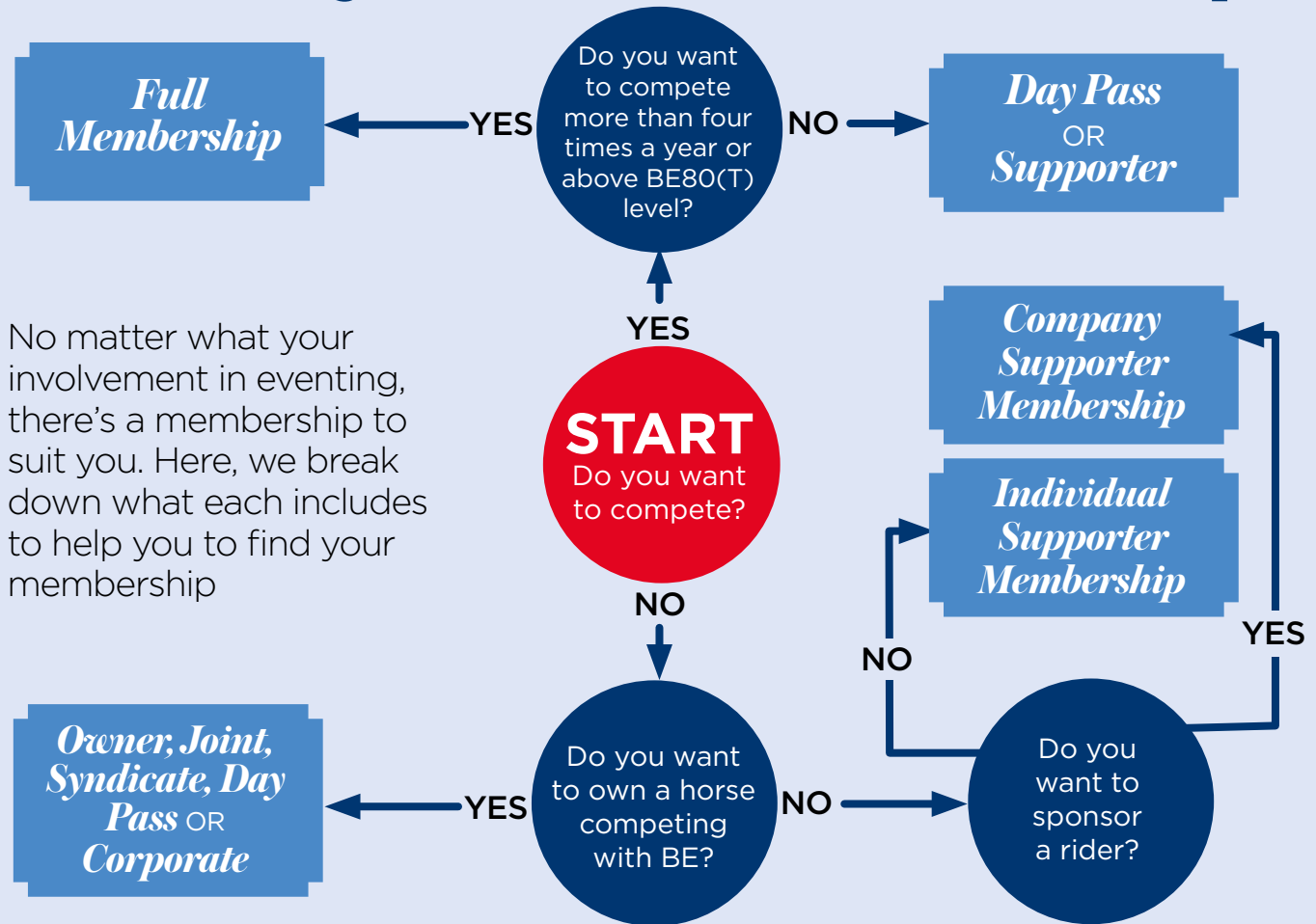


# Know your memberships



No matter what your involvement in eventing, there's a membership to suit you. Here, we break down what each includes to help you to find your membership

## FULL INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIP

- Third party insurance on horse-related activity
- Compete at BE events
- Own a horse with a current season ticket
- Discounts on various equestrian and non-equestrian events
- Free admission to events up to CCI2\*-L
- Discount on training and winter series
- Bi-monthly *British Eventing Life* magazine

## OWNING MEMBERSHIPS:

Benefits include:

- Third party insurance for current season ticket horses
- Own a horse with a current season ticket
- Discounts on various equestrian and non-equestrian events
- Free admission to events up to CCI2\*
- Discount on training and winter series
- Bi-monthly *British Eventing Life* magazine

## INDIVIDUAL OWNER MEMBERSHIP

For sole owners of a horse who do not ride their horse in competitions.

## JOINT OWNER

This is for two members owning a horse.

## SYNDICATE

If there are three or more owners of a horse then this is the membership you need. The first three members get the benefits shown below. Any further members can be added at an extra fee.

## CORPORATE

Any company owning a horse needs to take up this membership and up to three people receive the benefits listed left.

## SUPPORTER INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIP/SUPPORTER COMPANY MEMBERSHIP

In addition to the following benefits, a Supporter Company Member may display their company logo on rider and horse

clothing at BE events (subject to approval and size restrictions).

- Ability to purchase Day Passes to compete at BE events (individual supporter only)
- Discounts on various equestrian and non-equestrian events
- Free admission to events up to CCI2\*
- Discount on training and winter series
- Bi-monthly *British Eventing Life* magazine

## DAY PASS MEMBERSHIP

- Ability to purchase Day Passes to compete at BE events (maximum of four events on Day Passes)
- Discounts on various equestrian and non-equestrian events
- Discount on training and winter series
- Bi-monthly digital issues *British Eventing Life* Lite version

Four year old horses can compete in a maximum of four BE90 4YO or BE80(T) classes in a season (including the Four Year Old Championships). Four year olds may only compete on day passes.
