- Develop a working knowledge of the u18 members within the designated Region in order to assist the U18 National Coach and the relevant Chairman of Selectors where required.
- Assist the Under 18 Regional Coordinator in making the team selection for the Regional Under 18
 Team Championships as per the Selection Policy and be responsible for delivering appropriate
 training and preparation for the team.

- Knowledge of the Sport of eventing.
- Knowledge of the Under 18 programme and the rules associated with it, and the Under 18 Championships.
- Good communication skills.
- Ability to work well within a team.

 the Under 18 Regional Team Championships (July/Aug), in conjunction with the regional
