DAY PASS INFORMATION

- You can compete at BE90, BE100, Novice and Intermediate Novice level (inc Opens) on day passes if qualified to do so see rule book
- Horses must be 142cm or over and aged 5 or older, horses with points can compete HC or in Open classes
- Riders must be in the calendar year of their 12th birthday or older when they may compete at BE 90 level. Riders in the calendar year of their 14th birthday 3 and above may compete up to BE100 level.
- Day Passes may be purchased separately for riders and horses. If the rider and horse are both un-registered with BE then both must have a Day Pass to compete. If either horse or rider is registered with BE, only the un registered part of the combination will need a Day Pass to compete.
- Day Passes can only be purchased by a Full Member or Day Pass Member.
- All Day Pass competitors and owners must hold either a Day Pass Membership, Full or Owner Membership.
- Day Passes provide BE public liability insurance cover for the event Full details available from BE.
- 8 Day Passes have no priority in the event of a ballot (see Rule Book) but the pass can be transferred to another event if balloted.
- Day Pass placings are eligible for prizes and rosettes.
- 10. Dressage tests are listed on the website and in the Rule Book, a copy of which is sent to all pass competitors.
- Entries can be made online or by paper entry form which will be sent to those using this form.
- REFUNDS: 95% refund will be given when: an event is cancelled, an entry is balloted, veterinary or medical reasons (proof to be sent with refund request). All refunds must be sent to BE before 31st December of the year for which the pass or passes were purchased.
- 13. HORSE NAMES: must be in the name in the horse's passport or in the name it previously competed under with BE.

BE80(T) INFORMATION

- Points 2,3 (rider age), 5, 6, 7, 8, 10, 11, 12 and above apply.
- To compete in BE80(T) classes a Day Pass Membership is required, plus a Horse Day Pass (unlimited) for each competition
- 4 year old horses may compete after May 1st in BE80 but can only compete in a total of 4 competitions throughout the year, including Young Horse classes.
- A 'How to Start Eventing' booklet is available from the office.
- Ponies that are at least 137cms in height without shoes may compete in BE80(T) classes only.
