



From Week Commencing 19th July

- 1. With HMG guidance now moving to reducing restrictions on Social Distancing, we will be reverting to delivery of our sport as before C19 Protocols were introduced in July 2020. However, there are a number of processes used during this time which we will continue to use until the end of the 2021 season. Please be advised that BE guidance will be based on protocols from HMG and that some guidance may differ within some regions of the UK. Please check event schedules for information.
- 2. <u>Behind Closed Doors</u> Events retain the right to run behind a closed doors policy. Should this be the case it will be stated in schedule or newsflash.
- 3. <u>Pandemic Refund Policy</u> This will remain in place, and will continue to be set by each event and published in event schedule.
- 4. <u>Limits of Personnel on Venue</u>– All restrictions on competitor support staff, owners, event staff, event volunteers and public will be lifted in accordance with HMG guidance.
- 5. <u>Social Distancing and Face Coverings</u>— The requirement to wear face coverings in law will be lifted. However, the Government expects and recommends that people wear face coverings in crowded areas such as public transport. The 2m Social Distancing rule will be lifted. All enclosed spaces and structures to be continued to be well ventilated and numbers of people monitored, to help reduce infection risks.
- 6. <u>NHS Covid App-</u> Using the NHS COVID-19 app helps stop the spread of the virus by informing you that you have been in close contact with someone who has since tested positive for coronavirus, even if you don't know each other. Events should make available their QR Code around the venue for people to check in.
- 7. <u>Competitor Limits</u> The rules covering the number of competitors an event can accept will revert to Rule 4.3 as per the 2021 Members Handbook for events running from Week 21.
- 8. <u>BIB Numbers</u>— These will continue to be printed by competitors and checked in to venue by the event at the entrance to the lorry park.
- 9. <u>Event Scoring</u> A live scoring platform to be continued to be used.
- 10. <u>Prize Giving and Screens</u>– An Event may revert to using scoreboards on event (electronic or paper). Prize Giving / Prize collection to be reinstated.
- 11. <u>Event Trade Stands & Suppliers</u>– All trade stands will follow HMG guidance for the provision of retail services. Event Photography and Video may return to an on event retail presence.
