

FEI HORSE AND RIDER REGISTRATION APPLICATION

- Under the FEI Eventing Rules, which you will find on their website www.fei.org, all horses and riders wishing to compete at any International event, **whether in Britain or Abroad, MUST** be registered with the FEI, via British Eventing. Entries made via the BE Website will not be able to be completed unless both the athlete and horse have current FEI Registrations.
- In addition to this all horses registered for the first time with the FEI must be identifiable with a microchip, compatible with ISO 11784 and ISO 11785.
- It is imperative that you read and familiarise yourself with the BEF rule book and rules for International Competition as **ALL** International (FEI) competitions are run under FEI Rules and Regulations.

- Once you have read the rules please sign and return the attached acknowledgment and agreement form for the anti-doping rules. Under the new regulations we cannot issue your FEI Registration unless we are in receipt of your signed form.

Riders in possession of an FEI Registration who are using any form of medication need to check the Global Drug website, reference on-line at www.globaldro.com to see whether they are required to submit a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) to the FEI. TUE forms are available to download from the FEI website. If after checking the Global Drug website you are still unsure, please contact medical@britisheventing.com

- Please note that registration of both horse and rider is renewable for each calendar year.
- All registrations must be completed prior to entry. FEI registration lists on www.fei.org are updated instantly. Rider & horse numbers will come on e-mail.
- Every horse entered at CCI 3/2/1* in a **foreign country**, and all horses entered at CCI 4/5*, CCIOs, Championships, Regional and Olympic Games, whether at home or in foreign countries, must have an Official FEI Passport or a National Passport approved by the FEI, as a means of identification and to establish ownership.
- Horses **taking part in CCI 3*/2*/1* in the country in which they are resident are not required to have an FEI passport. All such horses must be properly registered with their NF and identifiable and, unless there is no national requirement for vaccination in the host country and in the country of origin, all horses must have a valid vaccination certificate.**
- All horses competing under FEI Rules are required to be vaccinated in accordance with FEI Veterinary Regulations and Rules for Eventing. All horses competing under FEI rules are required to be vaccinated in accordance with FEI Veterinary Regulations and FEI Rules for Eventing. You will need to make sure that your vaccination record in your horse's passport is up to date and complete, showing the full history including the primary course and all yearly boosters – all passports will be checked.
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- ALL horses competing at ALL FEI Events must fulfil the Horse Health Requirements via the FEI HorseApp. More information can be found here: <https://inside.fei.org/hub/horse-health>
