## Brock Supply breaks ground on Terrell facility

State and city government officials and business leaders from various Terrell entities were on hand April 27 to break ground on the site of a future Brock Supply Company warehouse in the Metrocrest business park on the west side of town.

Jerry Brock, the company's founder was very happy to be expanding his company at a time when many firms are looking for ways to cut back.

"We feel fortunate to be

doing well enough to expand at this time, we are pretty optimistic about it," Brock said. "The automotive salvage industry cannot find enough parts to supply all of their customers, which provides the need for our products."

Brock Supply, which is based in Tempe, Ariz. produces replacement automotive parts for sale through parts resellers and automotive recyclers nationwide and in some foreign countries. Locating

a warehouse in Terrell gives Brock a centralized distribution point for their operations.

"We worked with UPS, and the demographics tell us that we should be here, or Kansas ... somewhere here in the middle," Brock said. "I ended up in touch with Danny Booth at the Terrell CVB who dragged me down here and we just went from there."

Speakers at the ceremony included Booth, Terrell mayor Hal Richards, Mr. Brock and

outgoing state representative Betty Brown, who focused on the additional employment that Brock Supply will bring.

"While 20 employees may not seem like a lot, it really is when you think about up to 20 families being supported, and 20 more people who don't face a long commute to the west every day," she said.

Brock is celebrating 50 years in operation, giving him a long-term perspective on business and handling the

economic ups and downs.

"Some of our customers are having a hard time, but that may not be the economy," he said. "There are a lot of them that are saying business is good. The theory is that people are fixing up and keeping older cars, and that seems to be working for us."

# Tractor show scheduled June 12-13

## North Texas Antique Tractor & Engine Club makes preparations for annual event at Ben Gill Park

The North Texas Antique Tractor & Engine Club will return to Terrell again this June for their annual show.

The event, which will be held June 12-13 at Ben Gill Park, will include a small engine display, a tractor display, hay baling, wheat threshing and corn grinding demonstrations, antique tractor pulls, kiddy tractor pulls and a bounce house.

The show is open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., June 12 and from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m., June 13.

Admission is free for children under 8 and \$5 for ages 9 and up.

Visitors also will have the opportunity to buy raffle tickets for \$5 for their choice of a rifle or shotgun.

Raffle tickets are \$1 each or six for \$5 for a chance to win one of two other raffles for a quilt and an electric saw.

Organizers said they expect to have close to 100 tractors and other pieces of machinery on display at the event. Concessions will be available for spectators to purchase.

A tractor parade will be held at 1 p.m. each day.

The tractor show was originally held at Samuell Farm in Dallas, but relocated to Terrell several years ago.
