

Worship Service Guidelines

Our Executive Team, along with other staff, put together a list of Reopening Safe Practices and Guidelines to help ensure a positive experience for anyone who wishes to attend our services.

To ensure social distancing is maintained at each campus, seating will be limited in the worship center at each service:

- 120 at Big Creek
- 350 at Mid Rivers
- 65 at St. Charles

Worship service attenders over the age of 9 will be asked to wear masks at all times while in the building, including throughout the worship service. However, we are not asking those without masks to leave. As a result, there may be some attendees present without masks.

To maintain the safest environment possible:

- One-way entrances and exits at each campus will help facilitate social distancing before and after each service.
- Services will be kept to around 55 minutes in length to allow time for worshipers exiting and entering, as well as cleaning prior to the next service.
- Following each service, hard surfaces will be cleaned.
- Offering baskets will not be passed during the service. Please use online giving or drop tithes or offering in the secure offering boxes located at each entrance/exit of the worship center at each campus.
- Attenders will be asked to follow instructions given by easily-identifiable staff and/or volunteers.
