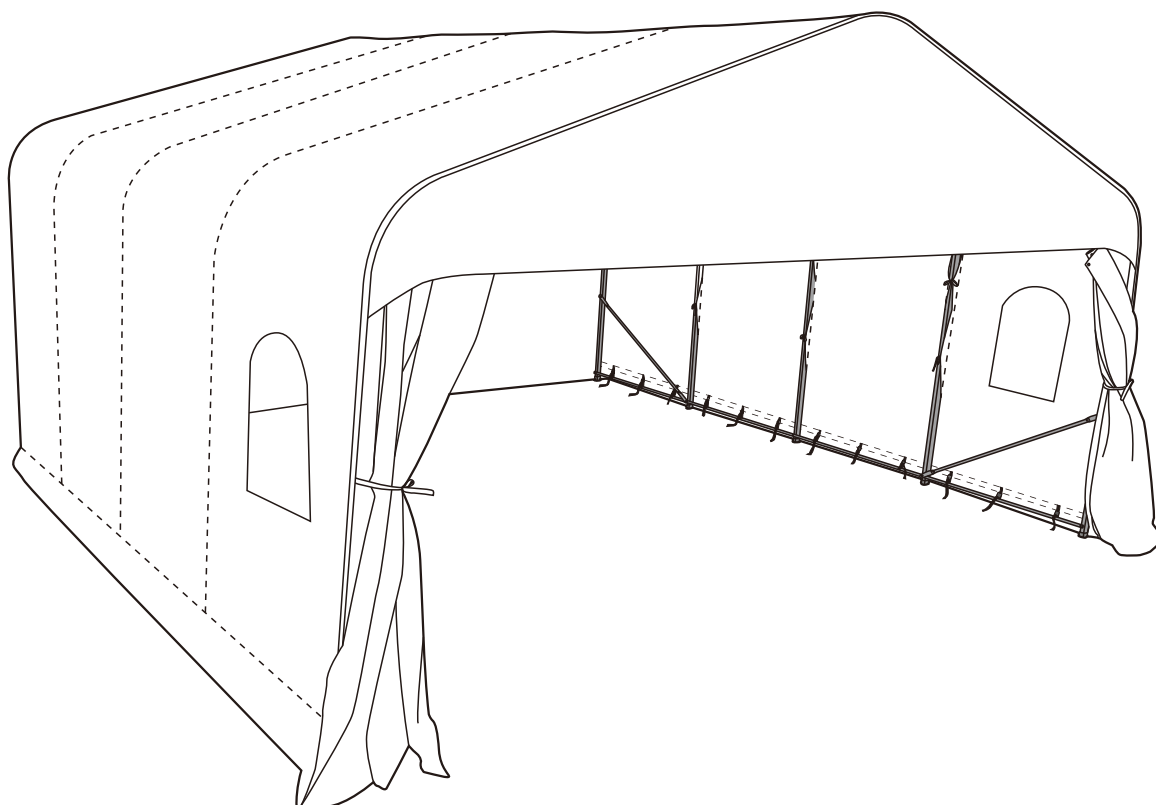

PREPARATION BEFORE ASSEMBLY & SAFETY GUIDELINES

N'oubliez pas de vous informer sur les lois municipales concernant l'installation de structures temporaires. Certains endroits peuvent exiger des permis pour l'installation et l'utilisation.

- Ancrez la structure sur un sol plat et solide (béton ou asphalte).
- Éloignez-vous des lignes électriques, branches d'arbres, et vérifiez l'absence de fils ou tuyaux avant de creuser.

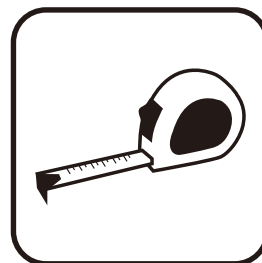
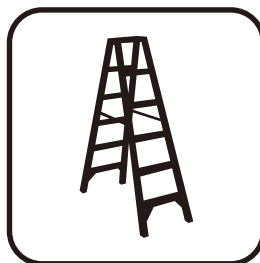
- Take photos of each side of the boxes and keep them.
- Retain the boxes and your proof of purchase until assembly is complete.
- Check the parts against the provided list before starting.
- Carefully read the instructions and assemble near the final installation location.

WARNING:

- Never step on the roof.
- Remove snow regularly to prevent accumulation.
- Anchor the structure on a flat and solid surface (concrete or asphalt).
- Stay clear of power lines and tree branches, and check for underground wires or pipes before digging.

WARRANTY LIMITATIONS AND EXCLUSIONS

- 1. Uncovered Damages:** This warranty does not cover damages caused by wind, falling objects, fire, animals, vegetation, vandalism, extreme weather conditions, or collapses due to the accumulation of snow and/or ice.
- 2. Positioning:** It is advised not to place the product near buildings or trees, as snow and/or ice may slide off and accumulate on the roof, causing excessive weight.
- 3. Installation:** The warranty is valid only if the product is installed in accordance with the instructions provided by Gazebo Penguin. Incorrect installation, such as improperly secured guide cables or inadequate anchors, voids the warranty. Any shelter that is not securely anchored may blow away and cause damage, which is not covered by the warranty.
- 4. Water Infiltration:** Water infiltration through the seams is not considered a manufacturing defect.
- 5. Condensation:** The warranty does not cover condensation, especially if the product is not installed on a surface such as asphalt, concrete, etc.
- 6. UV Rays and Storage:** The cover material is UV-resistant, but the product should be disassembled and stored during the summer months to prolong its lifespan. The fabric must be clean and dry before storage. It is recommended to keep the original packaging for storage purposes.
- 7. Fading and Wear:** Fading and normal wear of the fabric are natural and are not covered by the warranty.
