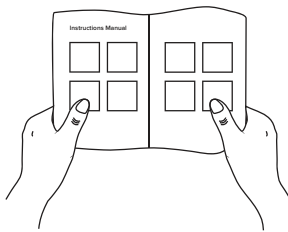
Before you start...



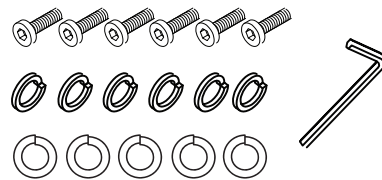
Check that you have received all cartons and familiarize yourself with the assembly requirements. This includes setting aside the allocated time required and having someone to assist you, if needed.



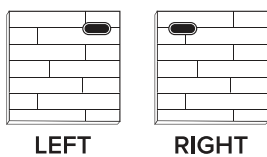
Ensure enough space for assembly. We recommend protecting your floor with a mat or cardboard to avoid scratches during the assembly process.



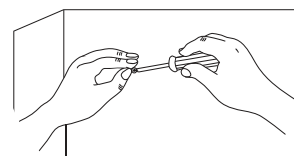
Read instructions carefully, and check that no parts are missing.



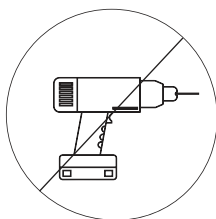
Lay out all hardware on a soft surface so you can easily identify them.



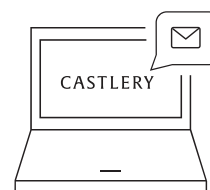
Carefully identify all components to differentiate which pieces are left and right.



Carefully install your new product following the instructions stated. Don't skip ahead!



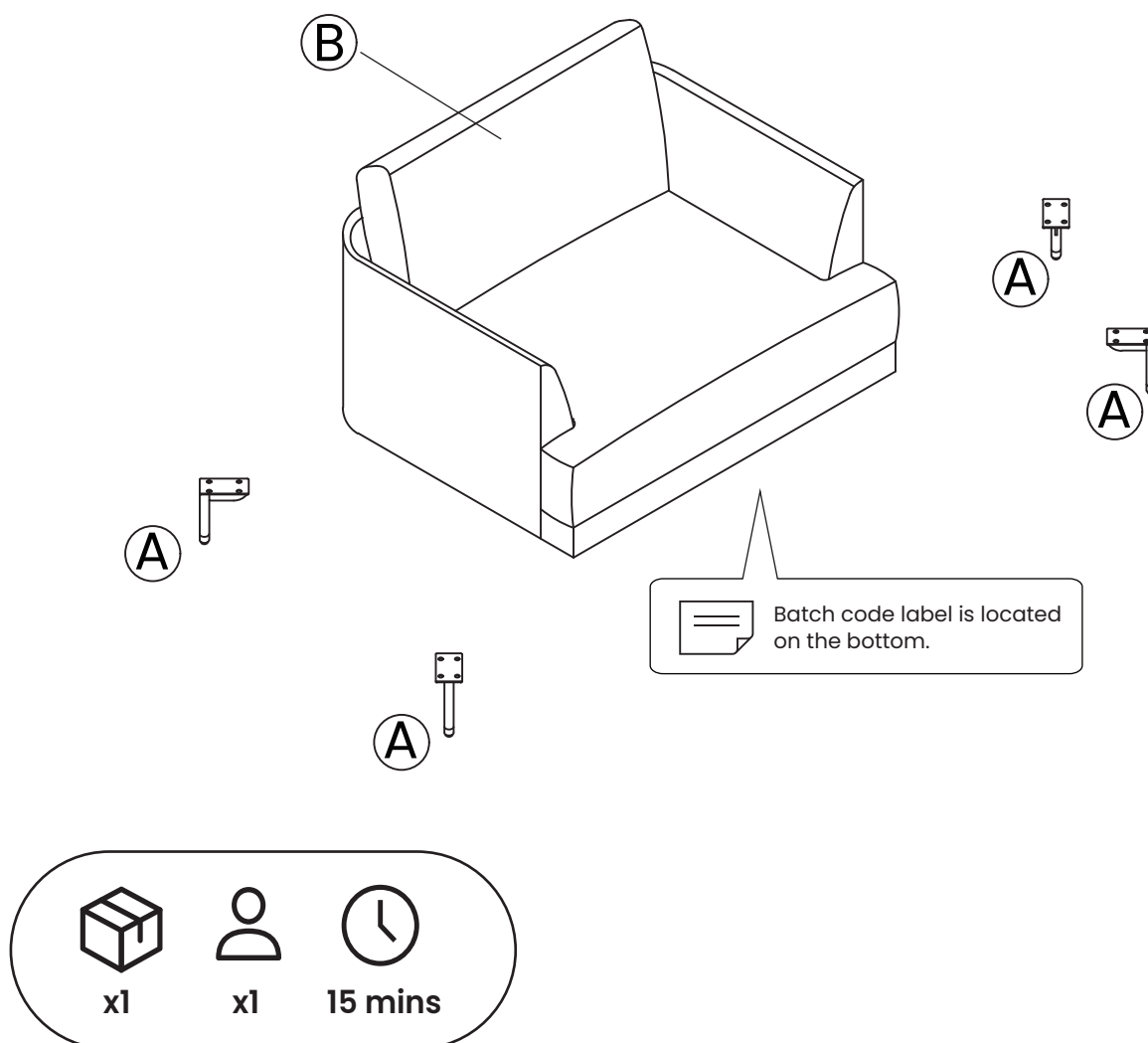
DO NOT over-tighten screws or use a drill. Only professional assemblers should use a drill.

Overview

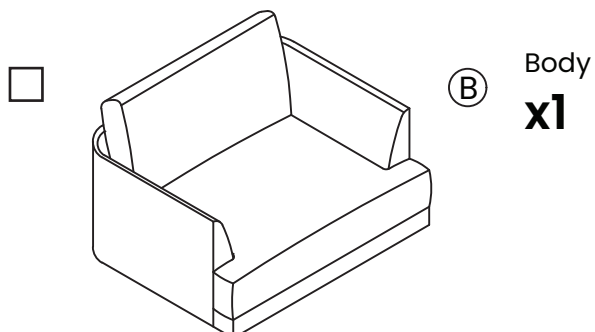
The sofa legs and bolts are in an inner box, right under the sofa seat zipper within **Box 1**.

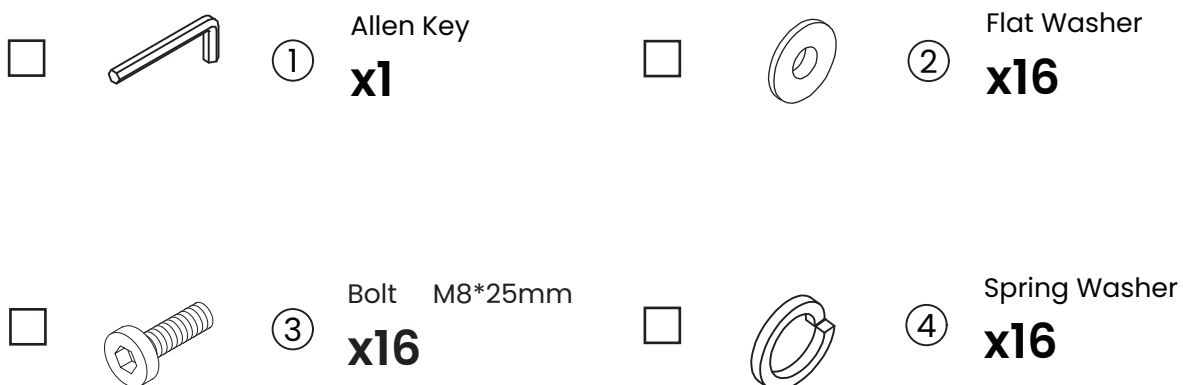

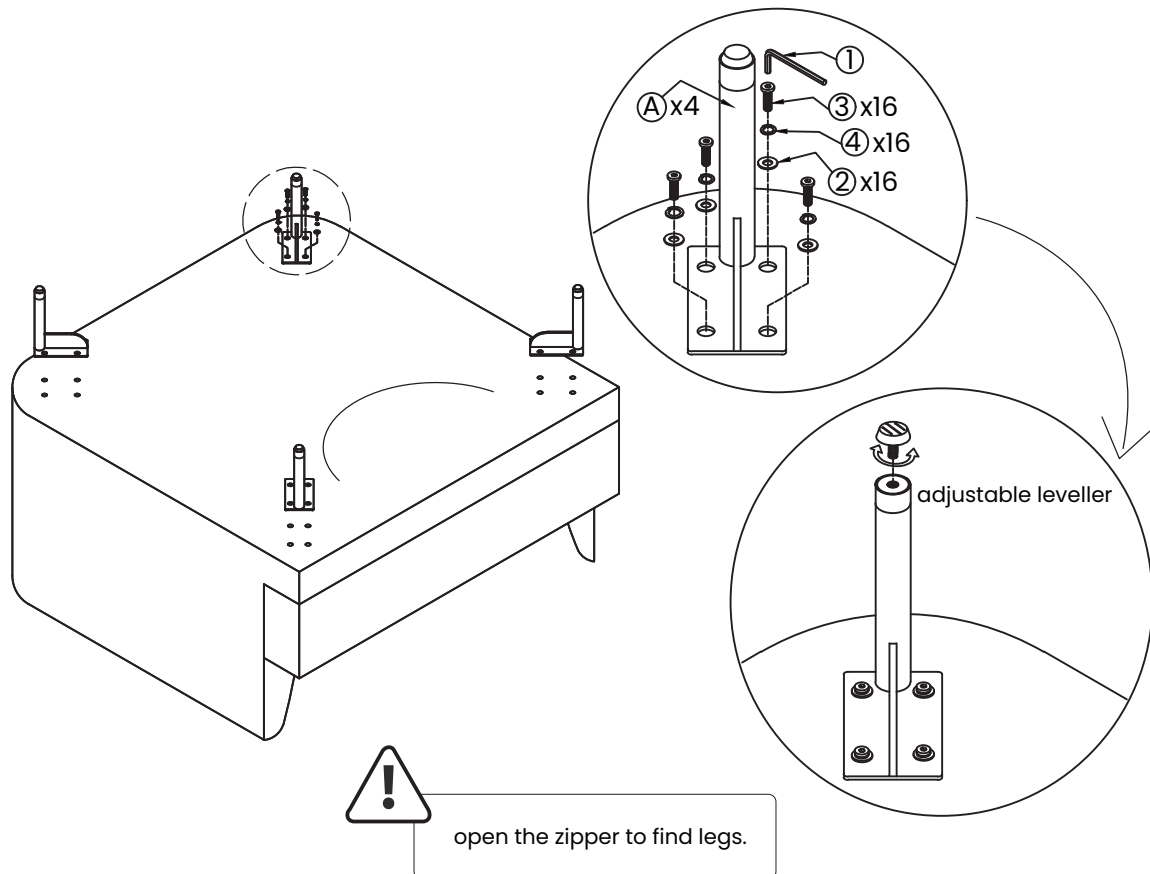

Please perform the following checks:

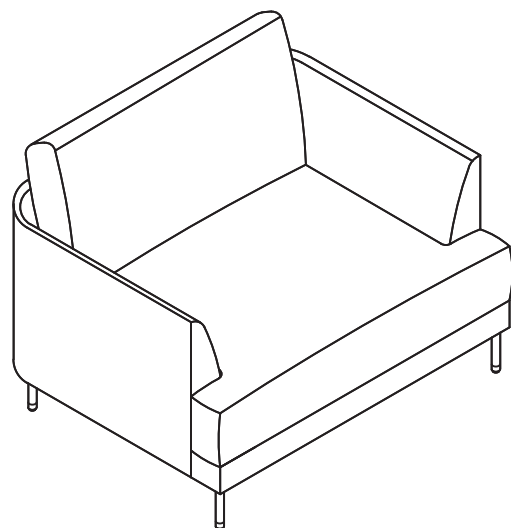
1. Ensure all bolts are tightened properly.
2. Ensure all legs are balanced.

Always lift your Castlery product when moving it to your preferred location. Levelers (if any) may slant if you drag your product.

Finally, dust the product with a clean cloth (if needed).

You're all set! Enjoy your new living space, thanks to the addition of your Castlery product.

Note: Your actual product may have minor size differences due to manual measurements.



Care

Instructions

Your furniture, if treated with respect and love, will last you a long time. Each piece requires light maintenance to maximize its longevity.

Fabric Sofa & Metal Legs Care

General Care

- Do not sit on sofa arms and/or back frame.
- Always move the sofa by lifting it at the base, do not drag.
- Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight and keep sofa away from any heating source to prevent fading or discoloration.
- Using a brush attachment, vacuum the sofa regularly to remove any dust particles.
- Blot spills immediately and gently with a clean microfiber cloth. Do not rub.
- Professional cleaning is advised for tough stains.
- Avoid sitting on the sofa when wearing clothing that may cause colour transfer.
- For removable cushions, flip, rotate and fluff the seat and back cushions regularly to prolong their lifespan and keep them plump.
- For non-removable cushions, to straighten folds and creases that form on cushions after prolonged use, smooth the surface with your hands and tuck any excess upholstery into the sides of the cushions.

Fabric Care

- Due to wear and tear, piling may occur. This is a normal occurrence and can easily be removed with a fabric shaver or fuzz remover.

Velvet Care

- Brush the velvet pile regularly to reverse the effects of wear and tear that might temporarily crush the pile.
- To straighten light creases, set your steamer at a low heat setting and steam in the direction of the pile.

Metal Leg Care

- Keep legs dry.
- Clean away dust or dirt with a soft, clean cloth.
- Do not apply harsh chemicals which may erode the finish.
- Use metal polish to maintain the shine of the metal. (Not applicable for powder-coated metal leg)
