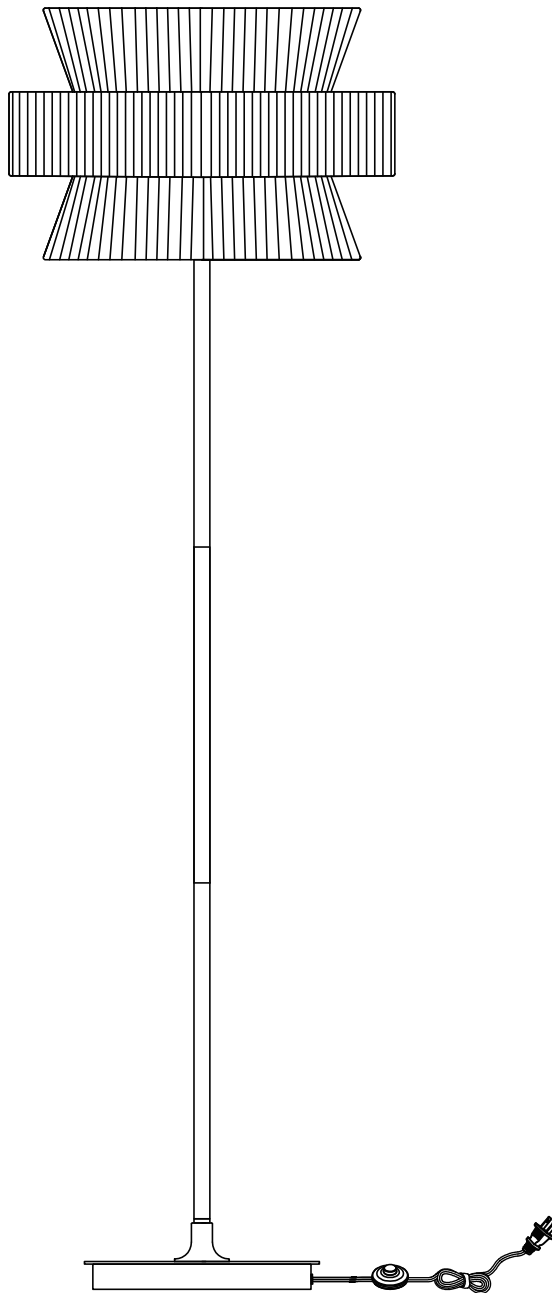


Blair Floor Lamp (US/CA Ver)

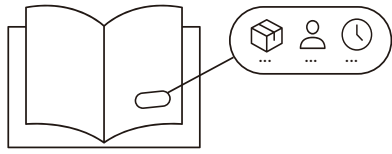

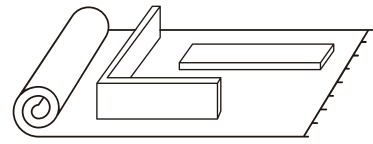

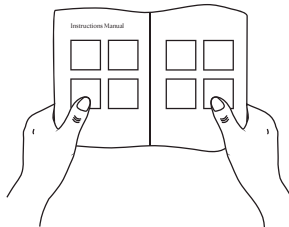
Before you start...



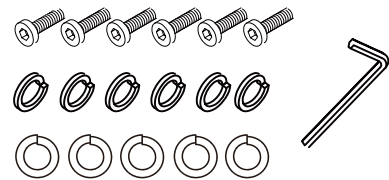
Confirm you have all cartons, review the assembly steps, set aside time, and get others to assist if needed.



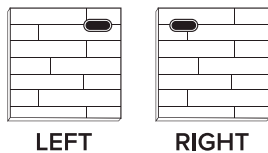
Ensure enough space for assembly. We recommend protecting your floor with a mat or cardboard to avoid scratches during the assembly process.



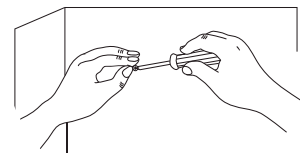
Read instructions carefully, and check that no parts are missing.



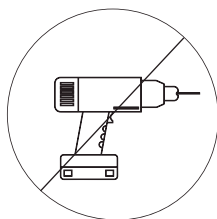
Lay out all hardware on a soft surface so you can easily identify them.



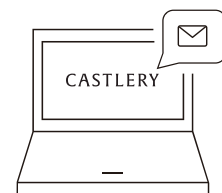
Carefully identify all components to differentiate which pieces are left and right.

Don't skip ahead!

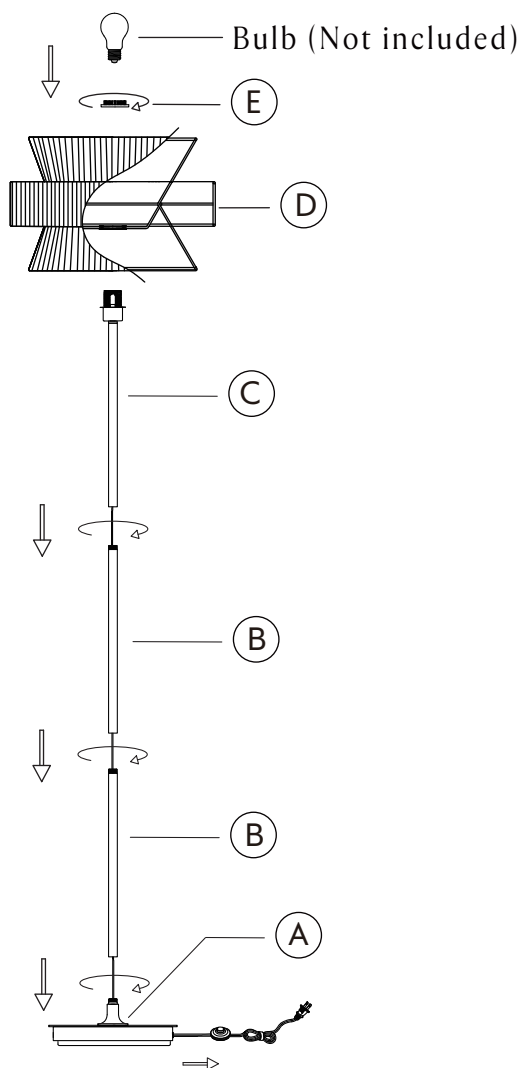


DO NOT over-tighten screws or use a drill.

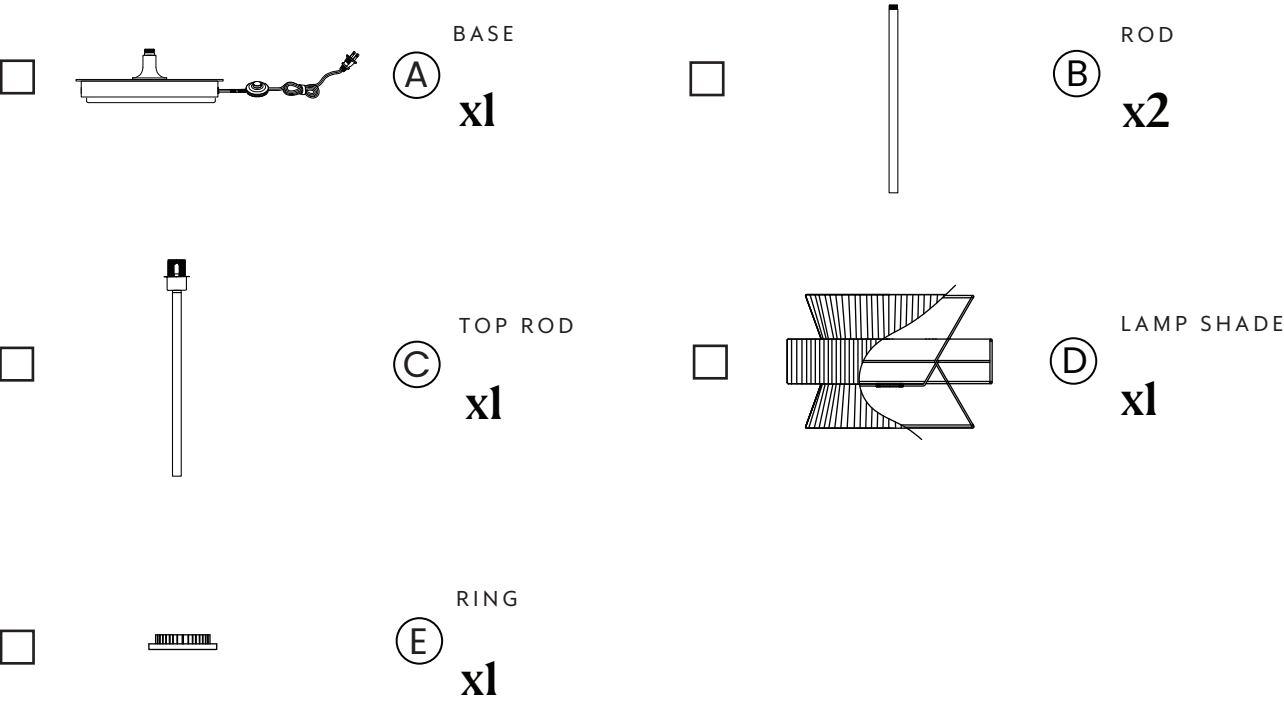

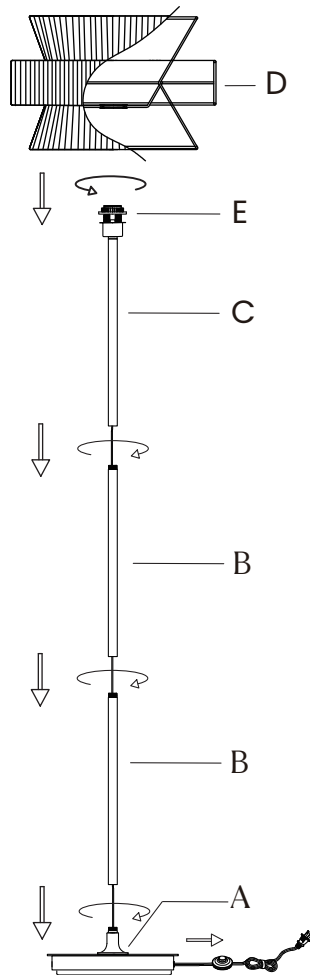


Product information

- It is recommended to use the product in indoor temperature less than 40 degrees

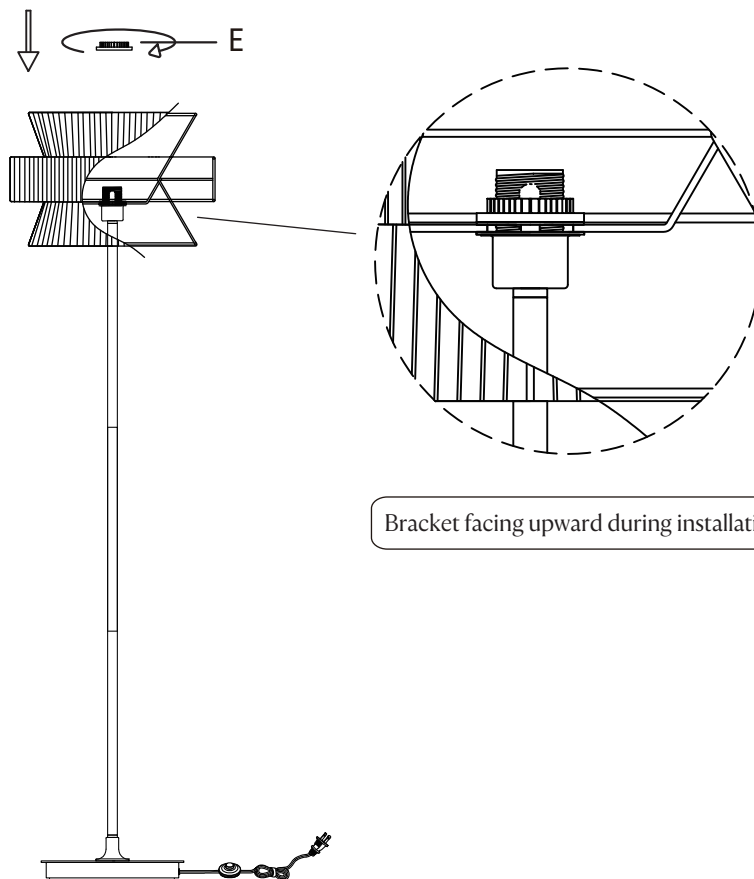


Step 1



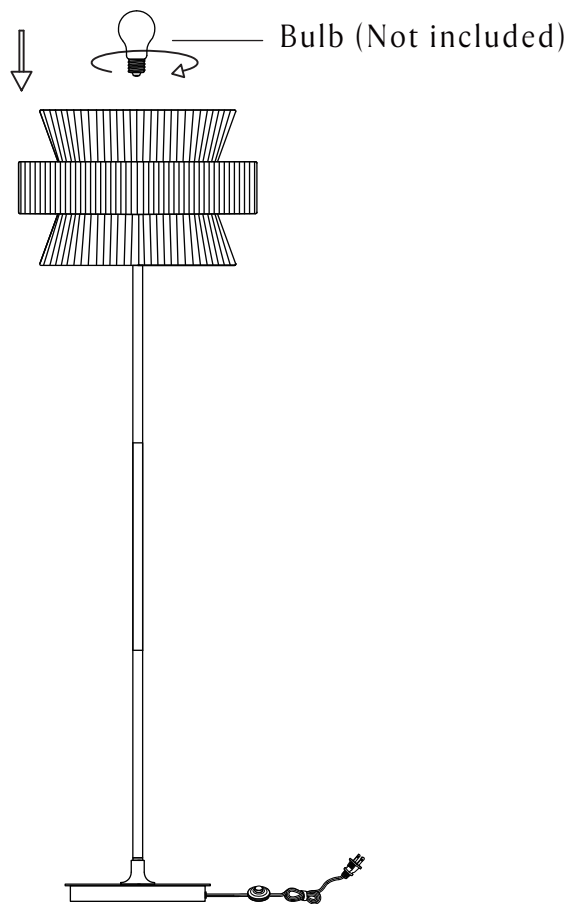
Unscrew the ring, and then fit the shade.

Nice work. Just one last stretch.

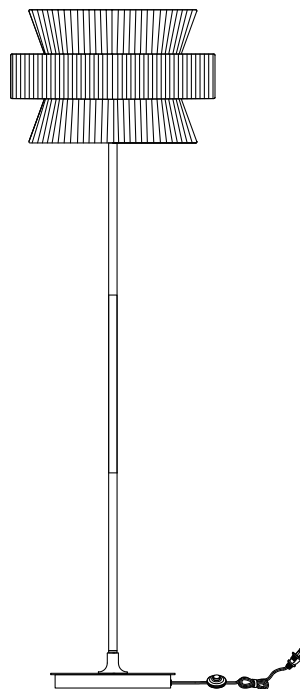
Please remember to check:

To ensure the Lamp shade are properly installed.

Always lift your Castlery product when moving it to your preferred location. Levelers (if any) may slant if you drag your product.

Finally, dust the product with a clean cloth (if needed).

Congratulations! Your Castlery piece is officially assembled. Now let the *living* begin.



Note: Your actual product may have minor size differences due to manual measurements.

Care instructions

Your Castlery piece is built to last. Treat it with love and respect—it will reward you for years to come.

Lighting care

- 01 Always switch off the electricity and allow it to cool before cleaning or replacing the light bulb.
- 02 Always handle the lamp with clean hands or protective gloves.
- 03 Remove the diffuser before cleaning the lamp using a feather duster or soft white cloth.
- 04 Ensure cleaning materials used are grit-free to prevent leaving scratches on the lamp shade.
- 05 Avoid using glass cleaners,abrasive cleaners,or bleach as they may cause discolouration on the shade.
- 06 Ensure light bulb is centred inside each shade and does not touch the shade sides.
- 07 The lamp can hold an E26 light bulb up to 60 Watt maximum.
However,do not exceed the recommended wattage to prevent risk of fire.
- 08 If the external flexible cable or cord of this luminaire is damaged,it shall be exclusively replaced by the manufacturer or his service agent or a similar qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.
