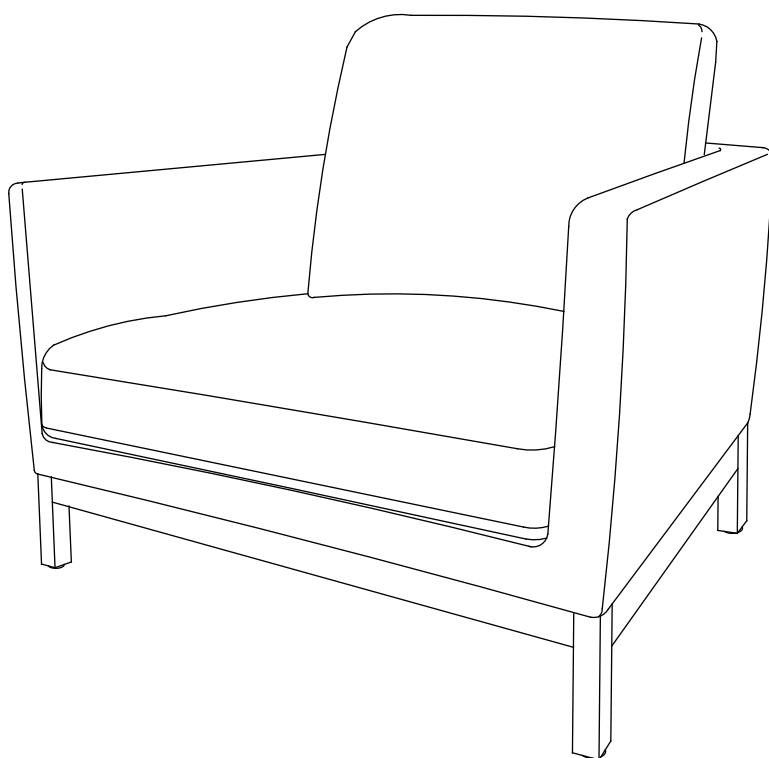

We obsess over every joint, stitch, and finish because we design for real life—the spills, the lounging, the hosting, and the years that follow. So having a place in your home means a lot.

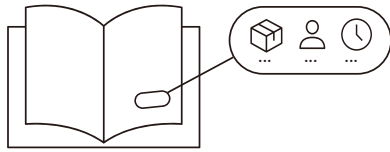

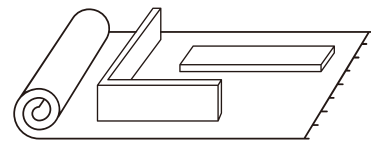

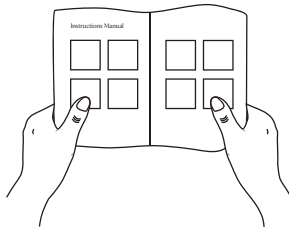
Before you start...



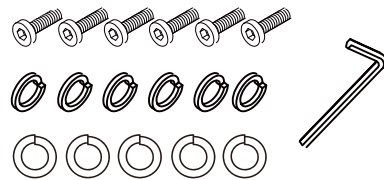
Confirm you have all cartons, review the assembly steps, set aside time, and get others to assist if needed.



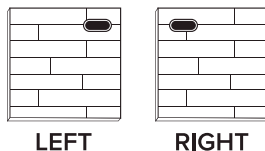
Ensure enough space for assembly. We recommend protecting your floor with a mat or cardboard to avoid scratches during the assembly process.



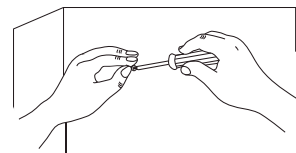
Read instructions carefully, and check that no parts are missing.



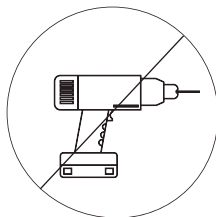
Lay out all hardware on a soft surface so you can easily identify them.



Carefully identify all components to differentiate which pieces are left and right.

Don't skip ahead!

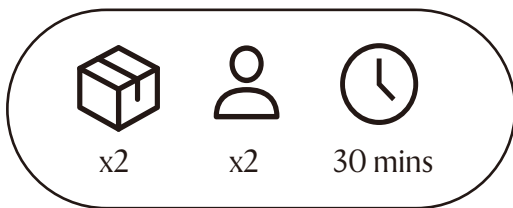
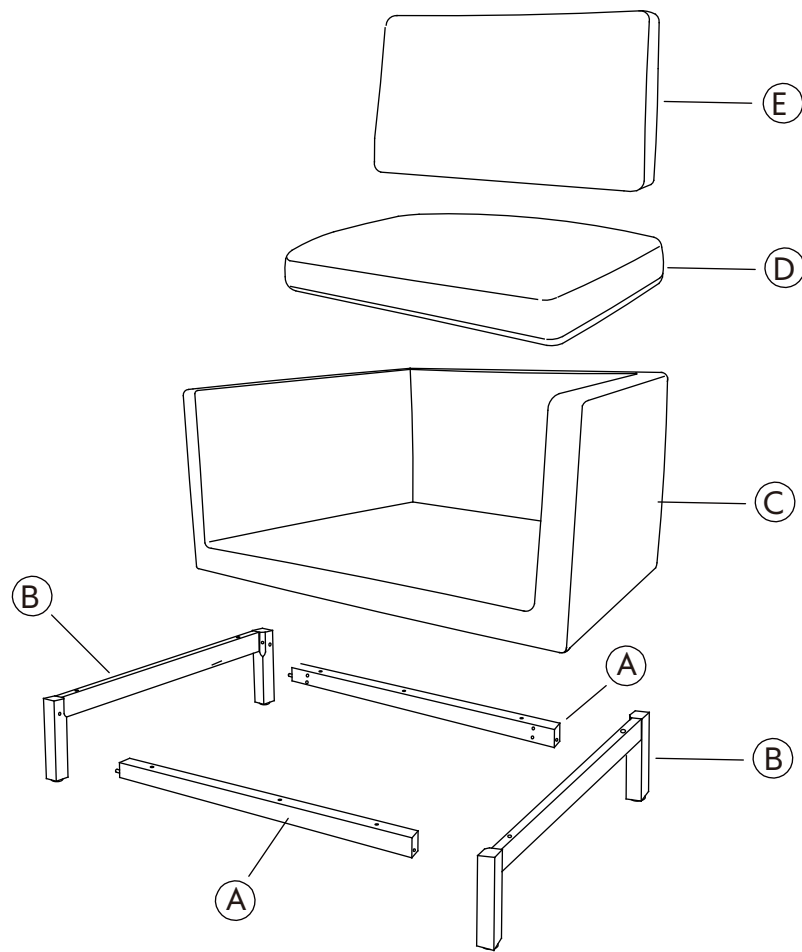


DO NOT over-tighten screws or use a drill.

Please do not completely tighten all the hardware, until each assembly step is complete.



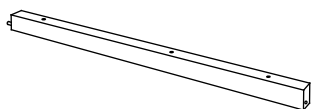

Please remember to check:

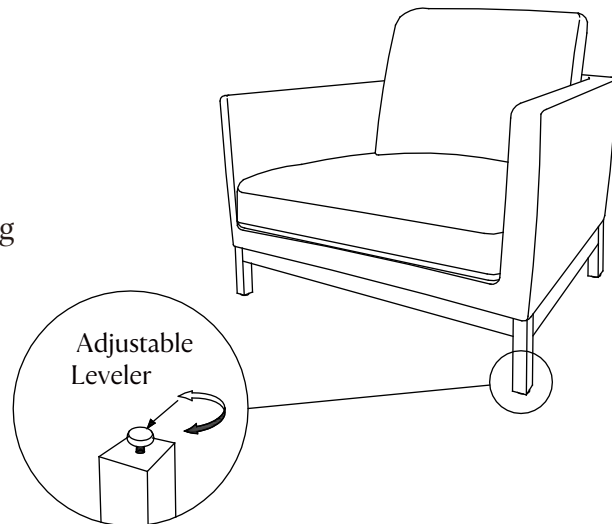
- 01 Ensure all bolts are tightened properly.
- 02 Ensure all legs are balanced.

Always lift your Castlery product when moving it to your preferred location. Levelers (if any) may slant if you drag your product.

Finally, dust the product with a clean cloth (if needed).

Congratulations! Your Castlery piece is officially assembled. Now let the *living* begin.

Note: Your actual product may have minor size differences due to manual measurements.



Care instructions

Your Castlery piece is built to last. Treat it with love and respect—it will reward you for years to come.

Upholstered Sofa Care

General Care

- 01 Always move the sofa by lifting it at the base, do not drag.
- 02 Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight and keep furniture away from any heating source to prevent fading or discoloration.
- 03 Vacuum the surface regularly to remove any dust particles.
- 04 Blot spills immediately and gently with a clean microfiber cloth. Do not rub.
- 05 Professional cleaning is advised for tough stains
- 06 Avoid abrasive cleaners and placing rough or sharp objects on the surface.

Fabric Care

- 01 Pilling may occur because of wear and tear and can be easily removed with a fabric comb or fuzz remover.

Leather Care

- 01 Use a leather conditioner to keep the leather soft and supple — let dry before sitting.
- 02 Avoid placing sharp items on the sofa, like keys or scissors.
- 03 A patina or slight sheen will develop on the surface of the sofa over time and is part of normal wear and tear of leather that adds character to the sofa.
